SUBJECT: Badlands Sanitary Landfill – Increase of Operational Hours for Commercial Customers (“Project”), District 5 [\$42,000 –Department of Waste Resources Enterprise Funds]. CEQA – Nothing Further Required.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that nothing further is required pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as all potentially significant effects of the Project has been adequately analyzed in the prior Badlands Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) Revision Environmental Assessment/ Mitigated Negative Declaration (EA/MND) No. 39813, Addendum No. 1 (SCH No. 2005041040); and
2. Authorize the Department of Waste Resources (Department) to revise operational hours at the Badlands Landfill for commercial customers to reflect 5:00 a.m.– 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, effective July 1, 2016.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Badlands Landfill is currently open to the public Monday through Saturday from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. In 2016 the landfill received an average of 2,240 tons per day Monday through Saturday. The site is currently permitted to accept up to 4,500 tons per day and open as early as 4:00 a.m. and close as late as 8:00 p.m.

In order to further stabilize tonnage commitments, improve operational efficiency, and attract new business to the Badlands Landfill, the Department recommends increasing the operational hours by one hour per day Monday through Friday. The hours will change from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings

The Project will not result in any new significant environmental effects, substantially increase the severity of the prior environmental effects, alter or include additional mitigation measures, or result in any other changes that may impact the prior significance determinations identified in the previously certified Badlands Landfill SWFP Revision EA/MND No. 39813, Addendum No. 1 (SCH No. 2005041040). Revising the start of the operational day by one hour (from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday through Friday) is consistent with the SWFP and prior analysis and impact determinations from the previously certified EA/MND. This action does not require an addendum to the prior EA/MND and a Notice of Determination (NOD) to this effect will be filed by the Department with the County Clerk upon Project approval.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed change will provide commercial haulers a safe, convenient, and environmentally compliant way to dispose of municipal solid waste without increasing traffic during morning and afternoon rush hour commutes. As such, no negative impacts to residents and businesses are expected as a result of increasing the operational hours at the Badlands Landfill.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

A slight increase in labor/benefit costs amounting to approximately \$42,000 per year are anticipated as a result of the added hour. Budget for this work will be provided from Fund 40200, Department ID – 4500100000.
