#### SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR AUTOMATED LIBRARY SERVICES

(Riverside County Library System and City of Murrieta)

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, Riverside County Library System ("County") has entered into a contract with the City of Murrieta ("City") for the provision of automated library services (the "Agreement") and both parties now agree to further amend the Agreement, to be effective on July 1, 2016:

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

A. Section 1 is amended as follows:

"The term of this Agreement is extended to include the time period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2018".

B. Section 3 is amended as follows:

"The total amount payable to the County for Fiscal Years 2016/17 – 2017/18 shall not exceed \$128,840 per fiscal year."

C. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain unchanged, and shall remain in full force and effect.
