

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

- 1. TEAM Evangelical Assistance Ministries \$2,500 the funding will be utilized to supply very low income residents with fresh food boxes, clothing and personal items in Southwest Riverside County.
- 2. Temecula Valley Rose Society \$1,000 the funding will be used to assist with purchasing a sun shelter and benches for the garden.
- 3. St. Carries Center for Human Development \$1,000 the allocated funding will support SMART Academy which provides STEAM afterschool and summer activities for disadvantaged children.
- 4. Center Against Sexual Assault \$5,000 the funding will be utilized to start a pilot program to address domestic violence in the San Jacinto Valley through therapeutic and advocacy services.
- 5. San Jacinto Chamber of Commerce \$200 the funding will be used to support the San Jacinto State of the City event.
- 6. Temecula United Methodist Church \$2,500 the funding will be utilized to support a fundraiser for the Temecula Community Food Pantry with its partner St. Vincent de Paul located at St. Catherine of Alexandria in Temecula that serves 15,000 people a year with food supplies.
