2. Approve the Reimbursement Agreement between the District and Homeland/Romoland ADP Corporation (ADP Corp); and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District; and

3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five (5) days of approval by the Board.

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BACKGROUND: (continued)

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the District shall be reimbursed by Homeland/Romoland ADP Corporation for the engineering, review, and construction costs of two (2) dry sewer laterals associated with APN 459-020-065, which shall be completed in conjunction with the District public works project Homeland MDP Line 1.

The District is the lead agency in administering a public works project to construct Homeland MDP Line 1 storm drain improvements within Briggs Road in the Menifee area. Homeland/Romoland ADP Corporation had previously been designated as the lead for the engineering, acquisition and construction pursuant to a Joint Community Facility Agreement approved by the Board of Supervisors in May 2006. The engineer and acquisition had been completed for the project but due to economic instability construction of this project never commenced.

Homeland MDP Line 1 is now a District project. After completing some necessary revisions to the engineering plans, the District was required to procure some additional right of way. During the negotiations with the property owner, it was brought to the District's attention that ADP Corp had entered into a Purchase and Sales Agreement with an owner to build two (2) dry sewer connections in conjunction with the construction of the storm drain improvements as part of the consideration for granting necessary easements for street and storm drain purposes. In order to fulfill this obligation, the District has agreed to include the sewer improvement into the public works contract. ADP Corp has entered into an agreement with the District to reimburse the District for the costs associated with constructing these improvements.

The agreement and related dry sewer lateral connections ("Project") was reviewed and determined to be statutorily exempt from CEQA, pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines §15273(a)(4), §15282(k) and categorically exempt pursuant to §15303(d); and a Notice of Exemption (NOE) has been prepared. Section 15273(a)(4) exempts funding mechanisms for public works projects; Section 15282(k) exempts the installation of new pipeline less than one (1) mile in length, whereas the activity in question is an 8-inch sewer line totaling only 106 lineal feet; and Section 15303(d) categorically exempts "New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures...water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, of reasonable length to serve such construction." The activity in question will not have a significant effect on the environment and the project is exempt from CEQA.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and ADP Corp has executed the Agreement.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Work shall be done at the same time as the storm drain improvements.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Reimbursement shall be the actual amount paid for the engineering and construction of the sewer improvements as part of the public improvement project. District shall have no financial responsibility for the sewer improvements after construction.





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REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT Homeland MDP Line 1 Project No. 4-0-00345 Sewer Connections Parcel 4345-1A

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This REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER REFERENCED AS PARCEL 4345-1 CONNECTIONS ON PSAROS PROPERTY __, 2016, by and between the ("Agreement") is made and entered into on Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, a body politic, ("District"), and the Homeland/Romoland ADP Corporation, a Delaware Corporation ("ADP").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, District, acting as lead agency is administering a public works project to construct Homeland MDP Line 1 storm drain improvements within Briggs Road from McLaughlin Road to Watson Road in the City of Menifee, Riverside County, California (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, ADP, previously designated the lead for development and construction of the Project pursuant to terms and conditions of the Joint Community Facilities Agreement entered into between the District and ADP approved by the Board of Supervisors for the District on May 23, 2006 as Agenda No. 11.3, acquired the rights of way from property owners along the Project route to construct Project, but did not commence construction of the Project due to economic hardship; and

WHEREAS, Georgiann Lonnie Psaros, George W. Psaros and Helen S. Psaros, (herein after "Psaros"), own certain real property along the Project route identified with Assessor's Parcel Number 459-020-065, further referenced as RCFC Parcel 4345-1A; and

WHEREAS, ADP and Psaros entered into that certain Agreement for the Sale and Purchase of Real Property dated January 21, 2007 ("2007 Agreement"), whereby Psaros agreed to grant necessary right of way to the public for the Project and as consideration ADP agreed to pay monetary consideration and construct two (2) 8-inch dry sewer laterals at its cost ("Sewer"), during the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Psaros executed all the necessary documents and was paid the agreed upon monetary consideration, but due to the incompletion of the construction of the Project, the sewer laterals were not completed and Psaros was not fully compensated; and

WHEREAS, a material inducement for Psaros to enter into that certain Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Real Property with the District, Psaros has requested that the District include the construction of two (2) 8-inch dry sewer laterals, within the public right of way, as outlined on the Project documents, "INSTALL 8 INCH SEWER LATERALS" (hereinafter "Sewer"). As this is outside of the District's Project, and pursuant to terms of the 2007 Agreement that ADP entered into with the Psaros', the District has agreed to include the Sewer improvements within the construction contract for District Project, provided ADP fully reimburses the District for all costs associated with the Sewer improvements; and

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WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement and the Exhibits attached hereto, is to set forth the financial and other arrangements between District and ADP for the construction of the Sewer; and

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NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recited premises, together with the mutual covenants herein contained and attached hereto, it is agreed that:

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AGREEMENT

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1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Construction of the Sewer located within District Project as shown on the project improvement plans, on file with the District and described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

The Engineer's Estimate for the construction of the Sewer is described in Exhibit "B",

attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein. It is mutually understood that

this estimate includes all construction costs, including, without limitation, construction survey and construction inspection costs, materials, specifications for Sewer work, and

administration of construction. Upon award of the contract to the successful bidder for construction of the Project, the District will accept the Engineer's Bid for the Sewer as the

The District has commenced review of the Sewer improvement plan prepared by Albert A.

Webb and Associates for Eastern Municipal Water District (hereinafter "EMWD"). The District has made a deposit to EMWD in the amount of \$3,000 for these services. The

review of the Sewer improvement plan is handled by EMWD as a deposit based fee.

Should the review of the Sewer improvement plans exceed this amount, the District will be invoiced by EMWD, would pay the amount due and seek reimbursement from ADP. If

there is a credit due, the District will be reimbursed. At the conclusion of the review the District will provide all accounting information provided by EMWD. All review costs

manner whatsoever limits or circumscribes ADP's indemnification of District. ADP's obligations hereunder shall be satisfied when ADP has provided to District the appropriate form of dismissal (or similar document) relieving the District from any liability for the

action or claim involved. The specified insurance limits required in this Agreement shall in no way limit or circumscribe ADP's obligations to indemnify and hold harmless the



Project Title: Homeland MDP Line 1 Reimbursement Agreement for Sewer Connection

Project Location – City: Homeland (unincorporated)

Project Location – County: Riverside

The project is located east of Interstate 215 off Highway 74 in the Homeland area. The Project is located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Highway 74 and Briggs Road in Homeland, an unincorporated area of the County of Riverside. The project affects Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 459-020-065. The project is within Township 5 South, Range 2 West, Section 18 of the Romoland 7.5 Minute US Geological Survey (USGS) Topographic Quadrangle. The properties are located at 33.741798 North, 117.135396 West (Lat/Long).

Project Description: The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) proposes to construct two (2) 8-inch dry sewer laterals provided that the District is fully reimbursed by the developer (Homeland/Romoland ADP Corporation). The "Project" is the reimbursement agreement and related construction of the two (2) sewer lines. The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the District shall be reimbursed by Homeland/Romoland ADP Corporation for the engineering, review, and the construction costs of two (2) dry sewer laterals associated with APN 459-020-065.

Public Agency Approving Project: Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

Public Agency Carrying Out Project: Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

Exemption: Statutory Exemption Pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines §§15273(a)(4), 15282(k); and Categorical Exemption §15303(d)

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The project qualifies for the following CEQA exemptions:

Section 15273(a)(4) "Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges" states that CEQA does not apply to the establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring, or approval of rates, tolls, fares, or other charges by public agencies which the public agency finds are for the purpose of obtaining funds for capital projects, necessary to maintain service within existing service areas. The project is merely a funding agreement which meets the intent of this exemption.

Section 15282(k): "Other Statutory Exemptions" includes of the installation of new pipeline or maintenance, repair, restoration, removal, or demolition of an existing pipeline as set forth in Section 21080.21 of the Public Resources Code, as long as the project does not exceed one mile in length. The 8-inch sewer line totals 106 feet in length.

Section 15303(d)(3): "New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures...water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, of reasonable length to serve such construction." The project qualifies for this Class 3 Categorical Exemption because it is merely the installation of 106 lineal feet of 8inch pipe integrated into an existing structure.

The project does not affect a change in the environment. The project will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the validity of the categorical exemptions as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Furthermore, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would reasonably occur that may create an environmental impact.

Based upon the exemptions identified above, the District hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.
