BACKGROUND:

Summary

Each Year in the fall, employees are given the opportunity to contribute to charities by payroll deductions. Board Policy C-14 provides for a single organization to head up the fund drive as the "Principal Fund Drive Organization" (PCFO) for a five year period.

On June 22, 2010, Agenda Item 3.22, United Way of the Inland Valleys was awarded as the Principal Fund Drive Organization. Human Resources recommends extending the agreement with United Way through June 2017 in order to support the continuation of services that are currently provided for this year's fundraising and offer a seamless transition into the RFP process when fund raising season has ended. All terms of the original agreement remain in effect.
