

**BACKGROUND:
Summary**

1. The LGBT Community Center of the Desert will hold the 6th Annual Center Stage Gala on October 28, 2016. This event will benefit the LGBT Community Center's programs such as the mental health clinic, community food bank and the health and wellness programs. Martha's Village provides on-site programs including transitional housing for homeless families and individuals, daily meals and addiction and recovery services. CID funds will be used towards the cost of rent, utilities, supplies and food for the meals served.
