BACKGROUND: Summary

The grant, awarded under the provision of Section 1872.8 of the California Insurance Code, is to be used by the District Attorney solely for the purpose of enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud and economic car theft cases.

Based on an estimated award, the DA's Office budgeted \$875,000 for FY16-17 in this revenue category. We are requesting a budget adjustment of \$5,500 to bring the budgeted revenue to \$880,500 for FY16-17.

The attached grant award and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.
