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#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary (continued)**

The construction, operation and maintenance of the project was analyzed as part of the Banning MDP IS/ND prepared in 1995. Due to the amount of time that has passed since the document was adopted, the District prepared an updated Initial Study to determine whether the IS/ND prepared in 1995 was still valid and that no new significant impacts would occur that were not previously disclosed. At the conclusion of the analysis, Staff found that no new environmental documentation is required based on the findings in the attached Initial Study.

Although the proposed project could have a significant effect on the environment, all potentially significant effects of the proposed project have been adequately analyzed in the earlier adopted Negative Declaration pursuant to applicable legal standards, all potentially significant effects of the proposed project have been avoided or mitigated pursuant to that earlier Negative Declaration, the proposed project will not result in any new significant environmental effects not identified in the earlier Negative Declaration, the proposed project will not substantially increase the severity of the environmental effects identified in the earlier Negative Declaration, no considerably different mitigation measures have been identified and no mitigation measures found infeasible have become feasible.

Furthermore, pursuant to Section 15162(b) of the CEQA Statutes and Guidelines, none of the conditions that would trigger a subsequent environmental document have occurred, therefore, the adopted IS/ND is still considered to be sufficient in fulfilling the proposed project's CEQA requirement and as such, no further documentation shall be prepared.

## INDEX MAP
