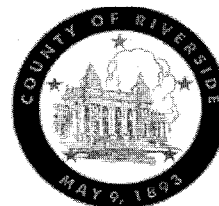



**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee will be used to sponsor their annual awards ceremony where law enforcement officers throughout Riverside County are recognized for going above and beyond in serving their community.
2. The donation to the Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee which will help them complete some special renovations to the national cemetery, including replacement shade cover for the amphitheater awning, a camera system for the front gate and the Medal of Honor Memorial.
3. The donation to Simple Acts of Care and Kindness will host the annual World Kindness Youth Conference where nearly 4,000 4th graders attend a day-long conference where they learn the skills of treating one another with dignity and respect with concrete steps to take in response to acts of bullying in their school.
4. The donation to VFW Post 10267 will be used for Post expenses like replacing flags, tables and chairs, painting, etc.
