Summary



LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A portion of parcel 1 of Parcel map 13816 in the Unincorporated Territory of the County of Riverside, State of California, as filed in Book 86, Pages 36 through 38 inclusive of Parcel Maps, in the Office of the County Recorder of said County, also being in Rancho Santa Rosa, more particularly described as follows.

COMMENCING at the intersection of Tenaja Road and Calle Dietel as shown said Parcel Map, said point being on a 1000 foot radius curve concave Southeasterly;

thence, Southerly along said curve through a central angle of 25°18′ 19″ a distance of 441.66 feet to the terminus of said curve;

thence, leaving said centerline at a right angle South 78°29'02" East a distance of 44 feet to the Southerly Right of Way line of said Tenaja Road said Right of Way being Southeast and parallel to said centerline and also being the Southerly terminus of a 956 foot curve concave Southeasterly;

thence, Northerly along said Right of Way line through a central angle of 10° 53′ 10″ a distance of 181.64 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**;

thence, continuing along said Right of Way line through an central angle of 01°11′55" a distance of 20.00 feet to the **POINT OF TERMINUS**.





Exempt Status: California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c)(2).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The vacation of a Portion of the Restriction of Abutters Access Rights has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(2). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, the vacation is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The vacation of the existing Portion of the Restriction of Abutters Access Rights will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The vacation will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. The vacation of this Portion of the Restriction of Abutters Access Rights will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is
no possibility that the proposed vacation may have a significant effect on the
environment. The vacation of a Portion of the Restriction of Abutters Access Rights will
not require any construction activities, change the use or intensity of the existing site to
create a physical environmental impact, and would not lead to any direct or reasonably

- foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would the vacation as proposed have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the vacation is exempt from further CEQA analysis.
- Section 15060(c)(2) for purposes of analysis under CEQA, the vacation of the Portion of the Restriction of Abutters Access Rights is not a "project" under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c)(2). An action by a public agency is only a "project" subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change in the environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or authorized by the County, in no way will the vacation of the Portion of the Restriction of Abutters Access Rights increase the use of the site, result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct, indirect, or cumulative physical environmental impacts. Any future development of the property will be subject to the permit review process and be subject to CEQA.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the vacation as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.
