## **BACKGROUND:**

## **Summary**

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District has requested the acceptance of a Portion of Watson Road for the purpose of acquiring an encroachment permit for the installation of a storm drain line. Watson Road will be accepted for public use but will not be included into the County Maintained System. The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District will be responsible for CEQA during the construction of the storm drain line. As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the Project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Categorical Exemption 15060(c)(2) and 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The Acceptance will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

This acceptance will have no impact on any residents or businesses.





**NOTICE OF EXEMPTION** 

**Project Name:** Accepting a Portion of Watson Road in the Homeland area.

Description of Project: Accepting a Portion of Watson Road in the Homeland area.

**Name of Public Agency Approving Project:** County of Riverside, Transportation Department, Survey Division.

Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project: Wesley Hohenberger, County of Riverside Transportation Department, Survey Division.

**Exempt Status:** California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c)(2).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The acceptance of a street has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(2). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The acceptance of the existing roadway will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. The acceptance of a portion of this street will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

- Section 15061(b)(3) General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is no possibility that the proposed acceptance may have a significant effect on the environment. The acceptance of a street will not require any construction activities, change the use or intensity of the existing site to create a physical environmental impact, and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would the acceptance as proposed have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the acceptance is exempt from further CEQA analysis.
- Section 15060(c)(2) for purposes of analysis under CEQA, the acceptance of the roadway is not a "project" under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c)(2). An action by a

public agency is only a "project" subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change in the environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or authorized by the County, in no way will the acceptance of the roadway increase the use of the site, result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct, indirect, or cumulative physical environmental impacts.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.
