Advanced Extrication Tech is an authorized vendor with the County of Riverside Auditor Controller's Office and they will be funding the transfer of these vehicles to the Ben Clark Training Center; therefore, there is no cost to the County of Riverside. The Riverside County Fire Department will not have any future cost for maintenance and/or repair of these buses since the plan is not to operate these buses. All combustible fluids (CNG, motor oil, gasoline, etc.) will be removed by RTA before delivering to BCTC and the intent of these buses is to leave stationary and perform extrication and rescue drills.

The transfer of these vehicles is beneficial for the Riverside County Fire Department as well as the surrounding Cities and Unincorporated areas. The buses will be used at Ben Clark Training Center (BCTC) for training purposes.
