

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On September 27, 2016, this Board received the declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer in the above referenced matter and declared the excessive outside storage and accumulated rubbish, located on the subject property to be a public nuisance. The Board ordered the property owner to abate the violative conditions on the property and directed County Counsel to prepare Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order to Abate.

Nos. 348, 541 and 725 15 16 17 The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on September 27, 2016, before the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor 18 19 Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real property described 41303 Sequoia Lane, Hemet, Riverside County, Assessor's Parcel Number 449-20 052-006 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY." A true and correct copy of a Thomas 21 Brothers map page indicating the location of THE PROPERTY is attached hereto and incorporated 22 herein by reference as Exhibit "A." 23 24 Sophia Choi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Michelle Cervantes, Acting 25 Supervising Code Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department. 26 27 Owner did not appear.

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The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer together

with attached Exhibits, evidencing the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as violations of Riverside County Ordinance ("RCO") Nos. 348 and 541 and as a public nuisance.

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

- 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the owner of THE PROPERTY as Arta Louise Mills ("OWNER"). Occupants reside on THE PROPERTY and their true names are unknown (hereinafter referred to as "OCCUPANTS").
- 2. Documents of title indicate that another party may potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to wit: Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc., acting as a nominee for Bank of America, N.A.(hereinafter referred to as "INTERESTED PARTY").
- 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on April 6, 2015, and on twelve (12) subsequent follow up inspections, with the last being September 20, 2016.
- 4. During each inspection an accumulation of rubbish and excess outside storage was observed throughout THE PROPERTY consisting of but not limited to: pylons, bottles, furniture, boxes, crates, appliances, hosing, carts, building supplies, trolleys, tables, car parts, pavers, blocks, wood, tarps, cardboard boxes, reusable bags, metal chairs, scrap metal, wheel barrow, bicycle parts, a gas can, red wood chip bags, wooden pallets, broken wood, clothing, bedframes, a child's stroller, plastic tubs, plastic crates, 5 gallon buckets, broken lawn furniture, household furniture, plastic storage containers, 50 gallon metal and plastic barrels, household appliances, pool ladders, chain link fencing, wooden backer board, steel, cinder blocks, constructions cones, tools, dyer vents, extension cords, plastic water jugs, beach lawn chairs, rolling metal tool boxes, fire it, BBQ, metal ladder, tires, Styrofoam, wooden baby crib, wooden bed frames, old rolled carpet, bricks, shopping carts filled with plastic piping and miscellaneous items, of about 5,950 square feet.
- 5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 6. On July 24, 2015, a Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings was recorded at the Riverside County Recorder's Office as instrument number 2015-0328758.
 - 7. On April 7, 2015 a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER and OCCUPANTS by

first class mail and was posted on THE PROPERTY on April 9, 2015. On July 29, 2015, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER and INTERESTED PARTY by certified mail, return receipt requested. On September 8, 2015, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER and OCCUPANTS by first class mail and was posted on THE PROPERTY on September 10, 2015. On June 10, 2016, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER by first class mail and certified mail, return receipt requested.

8. A "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors was mailed to OWNER, OCCUPANTS and INTERESTED PARTY by first class mail and was posted on THE PROPERTY.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on September 27, 2016, finds and concludes that:

- 1. WHEREAS, the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 41303 Sequoia Lane, Hemet, Riverside County, California, also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 449-052-006 violates RCO Nos. 348 and 541 and constitutes a public nuisance.
- 2. WHEREAS, the OWNER, occupants and any other person having possession or control of THE PROPERTY shall abate the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days.
- 3. WHEREAS, the OWNER, OCCUPANTS and INTERESTED PARTY ARE FURTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6.

ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS ORDERED that the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials

on THE PROPERTY be abated by OWNER or anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541, within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order to Abate Nuisance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials are not removed and disposed of in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials may be abated and disposed of by representatives of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's consent or a Court Order when necessary under applicable law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable abatement costs, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code section 25845 and RCO Nos. 348, 541, and 725. Under RCO No. 725, "abatement costs" means "any costs or expenses reasonably related to the abatement of conditions which violate County Land Use Ordinances, and shall include, but not be limited to, enforcement, investigation, collection and administrative costs, attorneys fees, and the costs associated with the removal or correction of the violation." Reasonable abatement costs accrued by the Code Enforcement Department will be recoverable from OWNER


