

WILLIAMS, OWNERS. 16 The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on September 27, 2016, before the 17 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor 18 Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real 19 20 property described 1 Parcel East of 19770 Carroll Street, Perris, Riverside County, Assessor's Parcel 21 Number 318-190-028 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY." A true and correct copy of a Thomas Brothers map page indicating the location of THE PROPERTY is attached hereto and 22 23 incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A." Sophia Choi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Michelle Cervantes, Acting 24 Supervising Code Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement 25 Department. 26 27 Owners did not appear.

The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer together

with attached Exhibits, evidencing the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as violations of Riverside County Ordinance ("RCO") Nos. 348 and 541 and as a public nuisance.

#### **SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE**

- 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the owners of THE PROPERTY as The Estate of George A. Williams and The Estate of Dorothea E. Williams ("OWNERS").
- 2. Documents of title indicate that there appears to be no other parties who may potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY.
- 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on September 3, 2015, and on eight (8) subsequent follow up inspections, with the last being September 19, 2016.
- 4. During each inspection an accumulation of rubbish and excess outside storage was observed throughout THE PROPERTY consisting of but not limited to: a boat, personal items, wood, tires, trash, gasoline powered generator, tools, buckets, clothing, washing machine, a barbecue, metal, a microwave, mini refrigerator, lights, construction materials, boxes with bedding and gasoline containers, of about 630 square feet.
- 5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 6. On November 2, 2015, a Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings was recorded at the Riverside County Recorder's Office as instrument number 2015-0481377 and on July 15, 2016, as instrument number 2016-0296907.
- 7. On September 3, 2015, a Notice of Violation was posted on THE PROPERTY. On September 14, 2015, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNERS by first class mail. On January 13, 2016, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER George A. Williams by certified mail, return receipt requested, and by first class mail. On May 18, 2016, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNERS by certified mail, return receipt requested.
- 8. A "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors was mailed to OWNERS by

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on September 27, 2016, finds and concludes that:

1. WHEREAS, the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 1 Parcel East of 19770 Carroll Street, Perris, Riverside County, California, also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 318-190-028 violates RCO Nos. 348 and 541

and constitutes a public nuisance.

2. WHEREAS, the OWNERS, occupants and any other person having possession or control of THE PROPERTY shall abate the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days.

3. WHEREAS, the OWNERS ARE FURTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6.

#### ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS ORDERED that the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials on THE PROPERTY be abated by OWNERS or anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541, within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order to Abate Nuisance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials are not removed and disposed of in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials may be abated and disposed of by representatives of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's consent or a Court Order when necessary under applicable law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable abatement costs, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code section 25845 and RCO Nos. 348, 541, and 725. Under RCO No. 725, "abatement costs" means "any costs or expenses reasonably related to the abatement of conditions which violate County Land Use Ordinances, and shall include, but not be limited to, enforcement, investigation, collection and administrative costs, attorneys fees, and the costs associated with the removal or correction of the violation." Reasonable abatement costs accrued by the Code Enforcement Department will be recoverable from OWNERS


