
**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

1. The Unforgettables Foundation - \$2,500 the funding is to be utilized to assist at risk families with burial costs for a child.
2. Diabetes Camping and Education Services - \$5,000 will be allocated to raise funding for research, education and to send young people with this difficult disease of diabetes to summer camp.
3. Big Brothers Big Sisters of Orange Co. and Inland Empire - \$2,500 to provide mentorships for underserved children for the Road to Success, Building Resiliency and Academic Achievement Program.
4. Riverside Nat. Cemetery Support Committee -\$2,500 for the maintenance, operation and beautification of the Riverside National Cemetery.
5. Habitat for Humanity - \$1,000 to be utilized for the Brush of Kindness Program for critical home repair and neighborhood revitalization.
6. Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee - \$1,000 funding will be used for the 39th Annual Law Enforcement Appreciation Dinner and Awards Ceremony which thanks and acknowledges the efforts of law enforcement officers.
