

BACKGROUND:

Summary:

1. The Riverside County Fair & National Date Festival will hold the 71th annual county fair on February 17-26, 2017. For the fourth consecutive year, the Fair will join forces with the Riverside County Department of Animal Services to host pet adoptions. The adoptions have resulted in the placement of more than 350 rescued animals into loving homes. The Riverside County Animal Services Department will be on site every day of the Fair, Monday-Thursday 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Friday-Sunday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., along with adoption counselors to help the public adopt a homeless dog or cat into a forever home. There are approximately 20-30 dogs available each day for the duration of the Fair along with temporary licensing on site. CID funds will be used toward the cost of a tent which covers the animals.
