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BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

Newport Road is one of the key east-west corridors in southwestern Riverside County. The interchange serves developing areas in the City of Menifee and unincorporated Riverside County.

The County is currently constructing the I-215/Newport Road Interchange in the City of Menifee. New loop on-ramps have been constructed and the existing ramps have been realigned. Newport Road will be widened to six through lanes between Haun and Antelope Roads and construction is substantially complete, however construction closeout activities are expected to continue to mid 2017.

On July 14, 2009 (Agenda Item 3-83), the Board of Supervisors approved the Cooperative Agreement between the County and Caltrans for the project development of the Newport Road Interchange at I-215. The current Cooperative Agreement will expire on December 31, 2016. As previously stated, project closeout activities are necessary; therefore, the termination date of the agreement will be extended with this amendment.

This Amendment has been reviewed and approved to form by County Counsel.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed Newport Road Interchange Project will reduce congestion, improve traffic flow, and improve public safety by improving the current traffic operations at the interchange.

Additional Fiscal Information

There is no additional costs associated with this amendment. The project is funded by the City of Menifee the utilization of Menifee Road and Bridge Benefit District (RBBD), Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fee (TUMF), Federal Surface Transportation Program, Eastern Municipal Water District, and Southern California Gas Company.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On July 14, 2009 (Agenda Item 3-83) the Board of Supervisors approved the Cooperative Agreement between the County and Caltrans for the project development of the Newport Road Interchange at I-215.


Vicinity Map



AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT, ENTERED INTO EFFECTIVE ON 29, 2016, is between the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, referred to herein as "STATE", and the

COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a political subdivision of the State of California, referred to herein as "COUNTY."

RECITALS

- 1. The parties hereto entered into an Agreement No. 8-1420 on July 22, 2009 defining the terms and conditions of a project to construct improvements to the existing interchange at Interstate 215 (I-215)/Newport Road in the County of Riverside, referred to herein as "PROJECT."
- 2. It has been determined that PROJECT will not be completed prior to the termination date of said Agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE MUTUALLY AGREED

- 1. The termination date specified in Article 23 of Section III of said Agreement is replaced in its entirety to read as follows:
 - "This Agreement will terminate upon completion of PROJECT that all parties have met all scope, cost, and schedule commitments included in this Agreement and have signed a cooperative agreement closure statement, which is a document signed by parties that verifies the completion of PROJECT.
 - However, all indemnification, document, retention, audit, claims, environmental commitment, legal challenge, hazardous material, operation, maintenance and ownership articles will remain in effect until terminated or modified in writing by mutual agreement."
- 2. All other terms and conditions of said Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This Amendment No. 1 to Agreement is hereby deemed to be a part of said Agreement.

SIGNATURES
