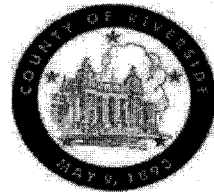

BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Fire Department/CAL-FIRE is preparing a new short-term one (1) year fire protection contract for the City of Calimesa. This Form-11 simply requires that the same contract terms and conditions be offered to the City of Canyon Lake.


Impact on Citizens and Businesses:

The residents and businesses of the City of Canyon Lake currently do not benefit from having a locally staffed city fire station (Station 60). Response times into portions of the City of Canyon Lake from adjacent external city fire stations can be lengthy, while negatively drawing down the resources of the neighboring cities. Offering the City of Canyon Lake the same short-term, one year contract as is being offered to the City of Calimesa will afford the residents improved services, while the city determines its long term fire protection service plans.
