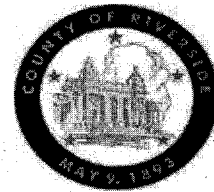



BACKGROUND:

Summary Continued

By Minute Order dated September 13, 2016 (Agenda Item 3-47), the Board of Supervisors approved the Columbia Street Resurfacing Project in the East Hemet area and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids. The project limits are from Florida Avenue to Stetson Avenue, approximately 1.2 miles.

The project will remove and replace the existing pavement. Additionally, the existing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalk that are in poor condition will be reconstructed, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) complaint access ramps will be constructed or reconstructed to comply with ADA standards.

Additional work includes removal and replacement of asphalt concrete berms, shoulder grading, manholes adjustments, new striping, pavement markings, and other work as required.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The proposed budget as shown on attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation Department) recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$1,116,441:

Base Bid Schedule: Columbia Street Resurfacing/Improvements within the County of Riverside
Alternate Bid Schedule 1: Columbia Street Resurfacing/Improvements within the City of Hemet

A portion of Columbia Street is in the City of Hemet (City); it includes the westerly half of the street, from Florida Avenue to 953 feet southerly of Florida Avenue. The City of Hemet concurred with the bid prices for Alternate Bid Schedule 1, as bid by the low bidder. The Reimbursement Agreement between the County and the City of Hemet is being submitted to the Riverside County Board of Supervisors for approval concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Construction is expected to begin in early 2017.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will benefit the project area by significantly improving the service life of the existing infrastructure.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2017. The roads will remain open during construction and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to All American Asphalt for the total amount of \$1,116,441. The project is funded with Gas Tax/HUTA and City of Hemet funds.

There are no General funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Five bids were received on October 12, 2016, ranging from \$1,116,441 to \$1,419,000. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$1,116,441, which is \$3,558 (0.4%) lower than the Engineer's Estimate.

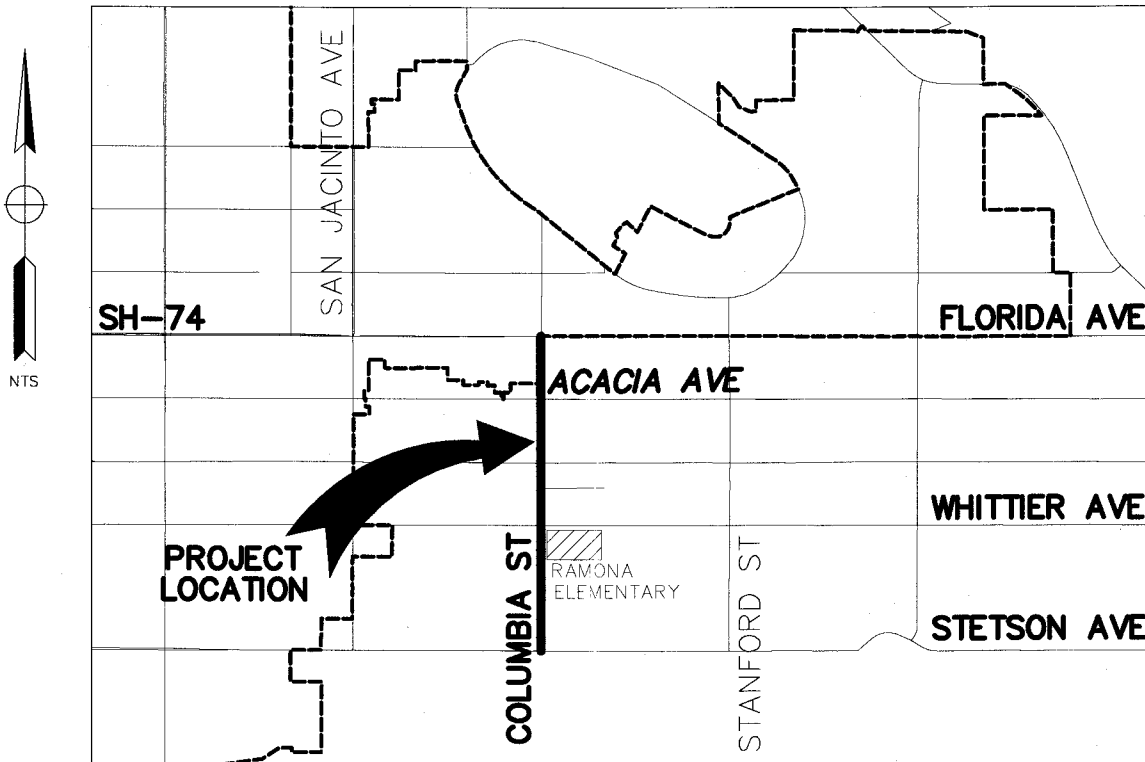
