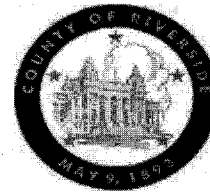

SUBJECT: TLMA-TRANSPORTATION: Approval of the Plans and Specifications and Authorization for Bids for the Van Buren Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation Project between Limonite Avenue and 56th Street in the City of Jurupa Valley, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Exempt. 2nd District (Clerk to Advertise); [\$690,000 - Total Cost]; Federal Funds 56% and Local Funds 44%

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Van Buren Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation Project is categorically exempt from the CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Section 15301, Class 1 (existing facilities) and Section 15061(b)(3) (general rule exemption); and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of Van Buren Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation Project; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids. Bids are anticipated to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 18, 2017 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate damaged pavement on an approximately 3/4 mile segment of Van Buren Boulevard between Limonite Avenue and 56th Street in the City of Jurupa Valley. The project will remove the existing asphalt pavement and place new Asphalt pavement. Additional work includes removal and replacement of asphalt concrete berms, grading of shoulders, new striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers and other associated work as required.

On June 21, 2016 (Agenda Item 3-77), the Board of Supervisors approved the Service Agreement between the County of Riverside (County) and the City of Jurupa Valley for the Van Buren Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation Project – Phase 1A. The Agreement outlines the agencies responsibilities for the construction of the improvements. The authority to administer the construction contract was designated to the County. The City of Jurupa Valley is responsible for funding the project.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Project No. C6-0087, Federal Aid No. - STPL 5956 (255)

Environmental Findings

The County will serve as a CEQA lead agency for purposes of securing funding for the project, advertising, awarding and administering the construction contract.

CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) describes the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of existing public facilities, with negligible or no expansion of an existing facility, to be considered as a categorical exemption under CEQA. This project qualifies under this exemption since it is a repair and maintenance activity of an existing road and associated facilities.

In addition, the Van Buren Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation Project is covered by the general rule of the CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). The Van Buren Boulevard Pavement Rehabilitation Project involves maintenance and repair to an existing roadway within existing right of way. As a result, there is no possibility that the rehabilitation project will have a significant effect on the environment. Therefore, the rehabilitation project is exempt from CEQA because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the project's activity may have a significant effect on the environment.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will benefit the project area by significantly improving the service life of the existing infrastructure.

The work is scheduled to begin in early 2017. Construction will be performed at night in order to reduce impact to traffic and reduce delays. The roads will remain open during construction and will take approximately one month to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$690,000. This pavement rehabilitation project will be funded with Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds and City of Jurupa Valley funds. No County funds will be used for this project.

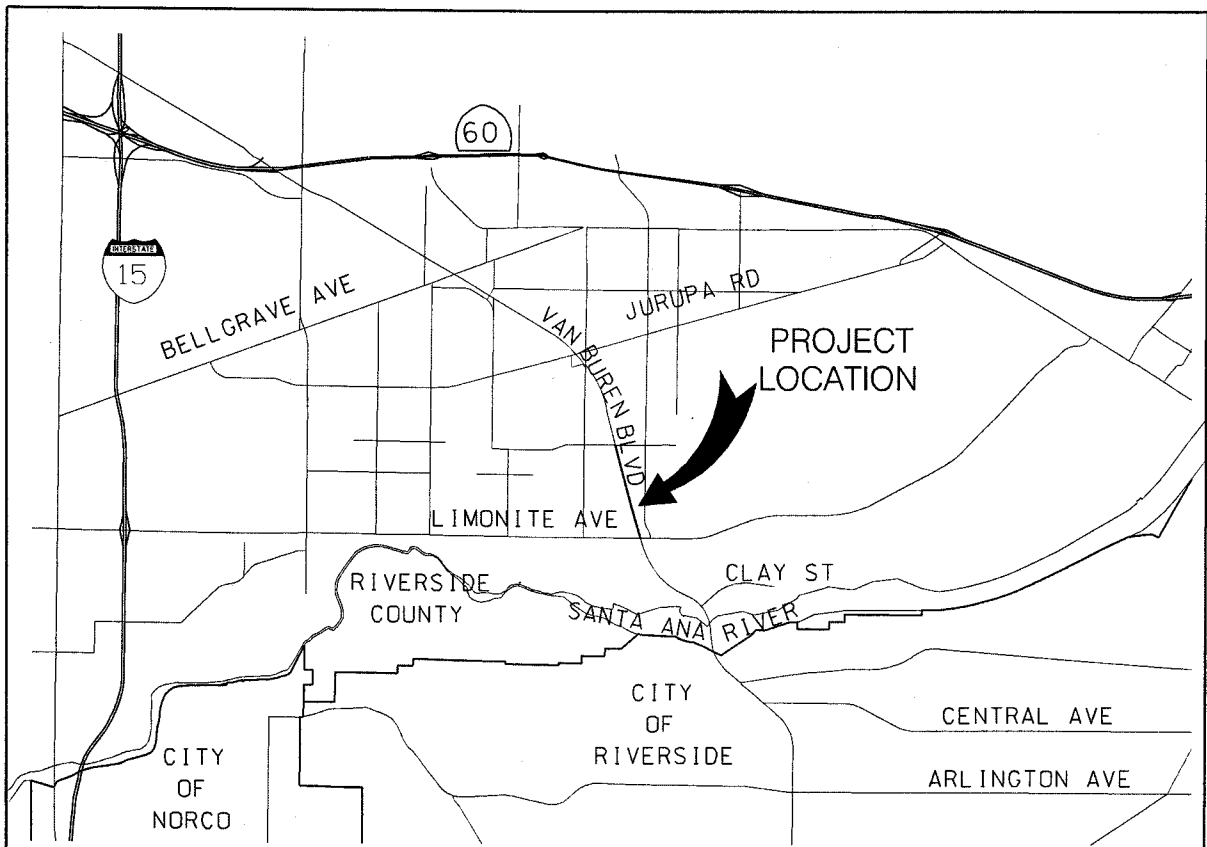
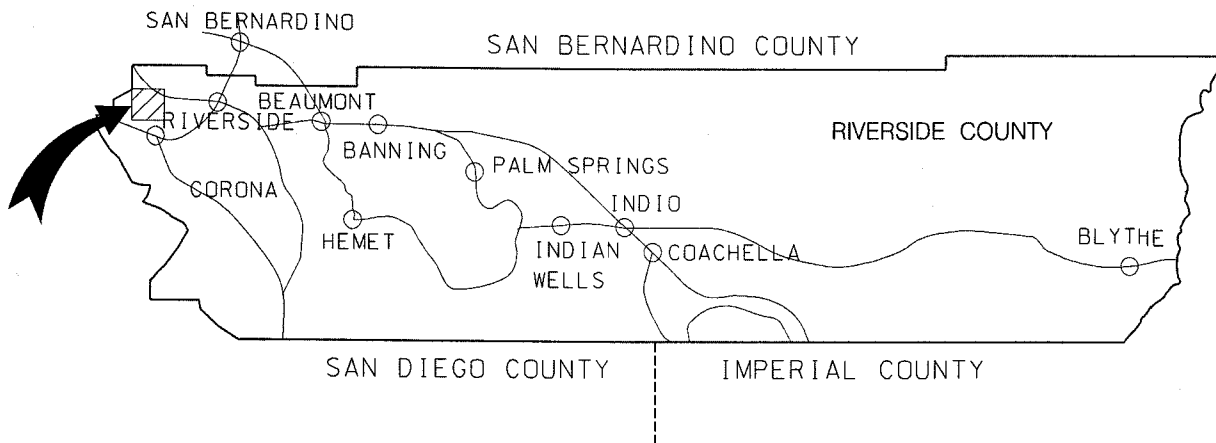
Vicinity Map

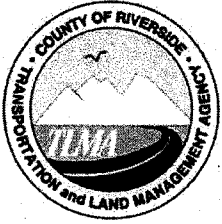

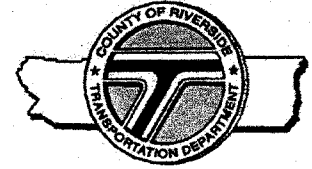
LIMONITE AVENUE To 56TH STREET

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City of Jurupa Valley (City) proposes to rehabilitate damaged pavement on Van Buren Boulevard between Limonite Avenue and 56th Street for a total distance of approximately 0.75 miles. The project will include the following:

- Removal of the existing asphalt pavement and placement of rubberized asphalt.
- Remove and replace asphalt concrete berms, grade shoulders, new striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markings and other work as required.

All project related work will take place within the paved roadway or roadway shoulder, within existing right of way.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The project involves maintenance and repair of Van Buren Boulevard through removal and replacement of damaged pavement, berms, and shoulder grading and pavement markings. There is no expansion of use as a result of the project. Since the project involves maintenance of an existing street, there is no possibility that the activity could have a significant effect on the environment. The rehabilitation of the road will be a benefit to the travelling public.

In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas.

The County of Riverside (County) Transportation Department has prepared this Notice of Exemption in the County's role as a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) lead agency in securing funding for the project, advertising, awarding and administering the construction contract.

The City is a CEQA lead agency because the project is within the City limits of Jurupa Valley, and the City has obtained funding for the project and prepared design plans. The City has prepared a Notice of Exemption for the project.

Federal funding has been obtained for the project; therefore, Caltrans, acting in its capacity as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) lead agency for the project, has determined that the project is Categorical Exempt from NEPA based on 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c) (22).


The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to rehabilitate damaged pavement and associated roadway facilities on Van Buren Boulevard. The project consists of maintenance and repair of an existing public structure involving no expansion of use and is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c). The improvements are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities.

Section 15061(b) (3) – General Rule Exemption – The project is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The project involves maintenance of an existing street, and therefore it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.


