

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The General Manager-Chief Engineer authorized this emergency work for non-native invasive vegetation removal within the Lake Elsinore Outlet Channel and Gunnerson Pond and has identified SAWA as the only organization having extensive experience and knowledge of non-native invasive removals in this area who have completed similar invasive removal projects for the Riverside Conservation Authority on their lands. The District believes SAWA has the unique qualifications, knowledge, skill set, and infield services to complete this project. SAWA has provided a quote not to exceed \$135,680.94 (Exhibit A) for work within the project area (Exhibit B).

The non-native invasive vegetation are both a detriment to the environmentally sensitive habitat within the river as well as an ongoing maintenance issue for the District. The services provided by SAWA will help reduce the ongoing maintenance cost as well as provide much needed conveyance capacity.



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RESOLUTION NO. F93-28

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RESOLUTION DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE GENERAL MANAGER
CHIEF ENGINEER AS TO CHANGE ORDERS AND EMERGENCY WORK

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BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the
Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District,
State of California, in regular session assembled on
August 24, _____, 1993, as follows:

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1. That the Board delegates to the General Manager-Chief
Engineer authority to execute in the name of the District written
contracts for material purchase or both work and material for the
repair or maintenance of District facilities without advertising
for bids if said contract for materials or work and materials does
not exceed \$15,000 pursuant to Public Contract Code §21091.

2. That the Board delegates to the General Manager-Chief
Engineer authority to execute in the name of the District, change
orders for any contract work for or upon District facilities as
follows:

For contracts with a contract price of \$250,000 or less,
a change or cumulative changes shall not exceed a total of ten
percent (10%) of the original contract amount.

For contracts of more than \$250,000, a change order shall
not exceed \$25,000 plus one percent (1%) of the original contract
in excess of \$250,000. An individual change order shall not exceed
\$100,000 and cumulative change orders shall not exceed ten percent
(10%) of the original contract amount.

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3. That the Board delegates to the General Manager-Chief Engineer authority to execute in the name of the District written emergency contracts for material purchase or both work and material for the repair, maintenance or safeguarding of District facilities, without advertising for bids, when in the judgment of the General Manager-Chief Engineer the public interest and necessity demand immediate action to safeguard life, health or property pursuant to Public Contracts Code §21091. In no case shall the expenditure upon any such written contract exceed the sum of \$300,000. Any such emergency contracts executed by the General Manager-Chief Engineer shall be reported to the Board in public meeting within fourteen calendar days following execution of such contract.
