

BACKGROUND:

Summary

In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, The Tax Collector conducted the May 5, 2015 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded June 18, 2015. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on July 22, 2015, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received two claims for excess proceeds:

- Claim from Sierra Dawn Estates Homeowners' Association, Inc. based on a Notice
 of Delinquent Assessment recorded May 12, 2011 as Instrument No. 2011-0209604,
 an Amendment to Notice of Delinquent Assessment recorded October 11, 2011 as
 Instrument No. 2011-0447896 and a Request for Notice Pursuant to Civil Code
 2924b(f) recorded July 11, 2013 as Instrument No. 2013-0335899.
- Claim from Carla G. Ferguson aka Carla Ferguson based on a Grant Deed recorded October 30, 2003 as Instrument No. 2003-857701, a Lot Owner Agreement recorded April 16, 2004 as Instrument No. 2004-0278062, a Quitclaim Deed recorded October 7, 2010 as Instrument No. 2010-0483255 and a Quitclaim Deed recorded October 7, 2010 as Instrument No. 2010-0483256.

Pursuant to Section 4675 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that Sierra Dawn Estates Homeowners' Association, Inc. be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$6,966.72 and Carla G. Ferguson aka Carla Ferguson be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$16,289.59. Supporting documentation has been provided. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion. Notice of this recommendation was sent to the claimants by certified mail.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Excess proceeds are being released to a lien holder and the last assessee of the property.
