

BACKGROUND:

Summary

In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, The Tax Collector conducted the May 5, 2015 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded June 18, 2015. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on July 22, 2015, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received five claims for excess proceeds:

- 1. Claim from Nationstar Mortgage, LLC, POA for U.S. Bank National Association based on a Deed of Trust recorded November 4, 2005 as Instrument No. 2005-0921162, an Assignment of Deed of Trust recorded April 2, 2013 as Instrument No. 2013-0156026 and a Limited Power of Attorney dated March 5, 2014.
- Claim from the Riverside County Department of Child Support Services based on a Notice of Support Judgment recorded November 4, 2011 as Instrument No. 2011-0493194
- 3. Claim from Franklin J. Love, attorney for Collection Consultants of California based on an Abstract of Judgment recorded January 8, 2014 as Instrument No. 2014-0008113.
- Claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Ruben Rodriguez based on an Assignment of Right to Collect Excess Proceeds dated February 11, 2016 and a Grant Deed recorded November 4, 2005 as Instrument No. 2005-0921159.
- Claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Manuel Flores Espinoza based on an Assignment of Right to Collect Excess Proceeds dated February 3, 2016 and a Grant Deed recorded November 4, 2005 as Instrument No. 2005-0921159.

Pursuant to Section 4675 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that Nationstar Mortgage, LLC, POA for U.S. Bank National Association be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$36,283.01. Since the amount claimed by Nationstar Mortgage, LLC, POA for U.S. Bank National Association exceeds the amount of excess proceeds available, there are no funds available for consideration for the claims from the Riverside County Department of Child Support Services, Franklin J. Love, attorney for Collection Consultants of California, Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Ruben Rodriguez and Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Manuel Flores Espinoza. Supporting documentation has been provided. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion. Notice of this recommendation was sent to the claimants by certified mail.
