BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to Queen of Hearts Therapeutic Riding Center will be used to help provide sponsorship for therapeutic riding sessions to folks with physical and mental disabilities.
2. The donation to the Corona-Norco YMCA will be used expand the Y's scholarship program for child care and after school care as well as provide for some on-going facility repairs and improvements.
3. The donation to the Mission Inn Foundation will help sponsor their annual fundraiser which raises funds to support educational programs such as Our Riverside Youth Education Program and provide for lesson plans and teacher workshops.
4. The donation to LULAC will be used to sponsor the 6th Annual Health Fair that will be held at the Cesar Chavez Center on February 25th and will provide free dental, vision and medical services for those in need and provide resources regarding free and low cost health services that are available in Riverside County.
