
RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:



BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, Inc. - \$500 the funding will be utilized to sponsor the 2017 Fair Housing Conference, "What will housing look like in the Inland Empire in 2025?" The conference will bring together community non-profits, government officials, lenders, builders, policy makers and housing providers to address the issues of the future of housing in the Inland Empire.
2. Mount San Jacinto College Foundation - \$2,500 the funds will be used to support additional MSJC Foundation Scholarships at the Foundations annual 2017 student scholarships.
3. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee - \$2,500 the funding will be utilized to support the Concert for Heroes at Riverside National Cemetery to recognize and salute all veterans who gave so much for the United States of America.

4. Community Mission of Hope - \$5,000 the funding will be used to support the inclement weather shelter which provides shelter to individuals from Temecula, Murrieta and southwest unincorporated areas during the winter months.
5. The Hemet San Jacinto Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1,500 the funding will sponsor Business Education Seminars for businesses in the Hemet San Jacinto Valley.
