

SUBJECT: RUHS - BEHAVIORAL HEALTH: Ratify the Contract Aggregate to Provide Substance Abuse and Prevention Treatment Services (District: All) [\$30,000,000 Annually], [\$90,000,000 - Total for 3 years] 92% Federal, 8% State

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


1. Ratify the annual contract aggregate amount of \$30,000,000 for Substance Abuse and Prevention Treatment (SAPT) services through FY18/19;
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign the agreements with SAPT providers listed in Attachment A, as approved to form by County Counsel for the term February 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017; and
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, based on the availability of fiscal funding and as approved by County Counsel to: a) move the allocated funds among the vendors for SAPT services listed in Attachment A; b) sign amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the agreements; c) sign annual renewals and amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed 10% annually; and, d) execute new SAPT Agreements that will be awarded through a competitive bid process for these programs, while staying within the approved annual aggregate amount of \$30,000,000 through June 30, 2019.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Riverside University Health System- Behavioral Health (RUHS-BH) operates a continuum of care system that consists of County-operated and contracted service providers delivering a variety of SAPT services within each geographic region of Riverside County. In August 2015, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) announced the approval of their 1115 Waiver application by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) to implement the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS). The waiver allows any California county who “opts in” to provide a full continuum of SAPT services currently unavailable to Medi-Cal beneficiaries. RUHS-BH submitted its DMC-ODS Implementation Plan on December 10, 2015 and it was approved by DHCS on July 8, 2016. On December 13, 2016 (#3-37), the Board approved Agreement #16-93238, which provides funding and service provisions for DMC-ODS. SAPT services include Outpatient, Intensive Outpatient, Residential, Peri-natal Residential, Medication Assisted Treatment, Opioid Treatment, Withdrawal Management, Case Management, and Recovery Services.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

These services are a component of Behavioral Health’s system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On May 17, 2016 (#3-20), the Board approved the FY16/17 contract aggregate for SAPT services in the amount of \$10,751,154. In anticipation of the DMC-ODS implementation, RUHS-BH in conjunction with Riverside County Purchasing, issued the Request for Qualifications (RFQu) #MHARC-196 on October 7, 2016, seeking qualified vendors to provide SAPT services within the DMC-ODS rates approved by DHCS. There were 114 bid notifications emailed and the RFQu was viewed by 230 individuals on PublicPurchase.com. Bid responses were received by 17 organizations. An evaluation committee reviewed the proposals and recommend awarding contracts to the providers listed in Attachment A.
