BACKGROUND:

Summary

On July 3, 2012 (Agenda Item No. 3.35), the Board of Supervisors approved the Agreement between the District and County Transportation Department (County) which set forth the terms and conditions by which the County will reimburse the District for deposits made to the Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) to expedite the evaluation and issuance of Section 404 permits of the Clean Water Act for District and County priority projects.

Amendment No. 1 extends the term of the Agreement to September 30, 2026 to allow for the continued evaluation of Section 404 permits for District and County projects.

The Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the County, the District, and the ACOE for the expedient review of permit applications for District and County priority projects appears as a separate agenda item.

County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to its legal form. A companion item appears on the Riverside County Flood Control and Water District's Board agenda this same date.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Entering into the cost share agreement will allow the transportation department the ability to respond in a time efficient manner to public demands on our road system.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Pursuant to this amendment and the MOA, the District will provide a maximum contribution of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to the Corps over a ten-year period for the continued evaluation of Section 404 permits. The District and County agree to cost share on an (80%-20%) basis of the project's actual cost. The County share will be approximately \$40,000 and will be funded with money from various local transportation funds. There are no general funds used for this effort.

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Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The contract cost is based on an approximation of ACOE staff time to review project documents. Actual costs may be less depending on the amount of work performed.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 to COST SHARE AGREEMENT

Water Resources Development Act of 2000 Section 214 Memorandum of Agreement

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, a body politic ("DISTRICT"), and the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California ("COUNTY"), hereby agree as follows:

RECITALS

- A. On July 3, 2012 [DISTRICT'S Board Agenda Item No. 11.1], DISTRICT and COUNTY entered into that certain Cost Share Agreement ("AGREEMENT") which sets forth the terms and conditions under which DISTRICT will make initial deposits to the Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District on behalf of DISTRICT and COUNTY to expedite the evaluation of Section 404 permits of the Clean Water Act for DISTRICT and COUNTY designated priority projects; and
- B. Pursuant to said AGREEMENT, the COUNTY will reimburse DISTRICT for their initial deposit and actual share of the costs thereafter; and
- C. To better facilitate funding for identified mutual goals and projects, DISTRICT and COUNTY desire to extend the duration of AGREEMENT to September 30, 2026.

NOW, therefore, in consideration of the preceding recitals and the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto mutually agree to amend AGREEMENT as follows:

Paragraph K in the RECITALS of AGREEMENT is amended to read:
 "DISTRICT has included the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) in its Fiscal Year 2016-2017 budget"; and

Section III.1 is amended to read:
 "The term of this Agreement shall start on January 1, 2017 and end September 30, 2026"; and

- 3. Section III.7 is deleted in its entirety; and
- 4. Except to the extent specifically deleted, added to or amended herein, all of the terms, covenants and conditions of said AGREEMENT executed on July 3, 2012 shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.
