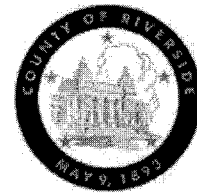

**Summary (continued)**

1. Habitat for Humanity Hemet / San Jacinto - \$2,500 the funding will be allocated for the Palm Avenue project, a two home project to provide homes for two families.
2. Girl Scouts of San Geronio Council - \$4,000 the funds will be utilized for Skyland Ranch Camp and specifically camperships for foster youth from the Third District.
3. Senior Citizens Service Center of Temecula Rancho Area, Inc. - \$1,000 the funds will be used to purchase food supplies for low income seniors and families.
4. Murrieta Chamber of Commerce - \$1,500 the funding will be utilized to sponsor the Murrieta Chamber Annual Awards Event which promotes economic development in the Murrieta area.
