




**BACKGROUND:**

4 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

5 EXTENDING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

7 **WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 8630, Article 14, of the California Emergency  
8 Services Act requires that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside review, at least  
9 every thirty (30) days until such Local Emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the  
10 Local Emergency; and

11 **WHEREAS**, a period of Local Emergency presently exists in the County of Riverside in  
12 accordance with the proclamation thereof by the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
13 Riverside, by Resolution No. 2017-039, on January 31, 2017, as a result of conditions of  
14 extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within said county, caused by a major  
15 winter storm which took place within the County of Riverside, through power outages; road  
16 and school closures; debris removal; swift water rescues; identified increased flood-related  
17 traffic collisions; failure to water treatment facilities; major communication system failure;  
18 damage to public and private infrastructure; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside has reviewed the  
20 need to continue the existence of the Local Emergency; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the situation resulting from said condition of extreme peril is still deemed  
22 to be beyond the control of normal protective service, personnel, equipment, and facilities of  
23 and within said County of Riverside; now, therefore,

24 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside does  
25 hereby proclaim the extension of the period of Local Emergency for thirty (30) additional days  
26 unless sooner terminated.
