BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Political Reform Act, Government Code section 81000, et seq., provides that each governmental agency adopt and maintain a Conflict of Interest Code.

Since 1986, the County has been using the standard Conflict of Interest Code found in California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 18730. Government Code Section 87306.5 requires that in every even year, all local agencies review their codes and make any appropriate amendments to their Conflict of Interest Codes, and the listing of designated positions for employees who must disclose along with the types of disclosure required. The county is considered a local agency under Government Code Section 82041.

The proposed amendment revises and updates the Appendix to the County's Conflict of Interest Code. The Appendix lists the designated positions and the disclosure categories.

The Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) requires that a public hearing be set for amendments to the County's Conflict of Interest Code and recommends a 45-day comment period. Following the 45-day comment period, the public hearing will occur, at which time the Board of Supervisors may adopt the Conflict of Interest Code.

On January 17, 2017 the Board of Supervisors set a public hearing for adoption of Resolution 2017-011 for March 14, 2017.

3 AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR
4 RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

5 WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires that
6 state and local government agencies adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes; and

7 WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, i.e., 2 California
8 Code of Regulations, section 18730, which contains the terms of a Standard Conflict of Interest Code,
9 which may be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices
10 Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act; and

11 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, on May 24,
12 2005, adopted the provisions of 2 California Code of Regulations, section 18730 and any amendments to
13 it as adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission with an Appendix in which certain enumerated
14 officials and employees and members of certain enumerated Boards, Commissions, Committees and the
15 Grand Jury are designated and disclosure categories to constitute the Conflict of Interest Code for
16 Departments, Agencies, and Bodies of the County of Riverside; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on January 6, 2015, amended the Appendix of the County's
18 Conflict of Interest Code; and

19 WHEREAS, as changed circumstances within the County have made it advisable and necessary
20 pursuant to Section 87306 and 87307 of the Political Reform Act to amend and update the Appendix of
21 the County's Conflict of Interest Code; and

22 WHEREAS, notice of time and place of a public hearing on, and of consideration by the Board of
23 Supervisors of, the proposed amended Appendix was publicly posted for review at 4080 Lemon Street,
24 Riverside, California, and duly published in a newspaper of general circulation in the County for a period
25 of two weeks; and

26 WHEREAS, the proposed amended Conflict of Interest Code was considered at a regular meeting
27 of the Board of Supervisors on January 17, 2017, at which all present were given an
28 opportunity to be heard on the proposed adoption of the amended Conflict of Interest Code; NOW,

1 THEREFORE:

2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in
3 regular session assembled on March 14, 2017, does hereby adopt the attached
4 amended Appendix of the County's Conflict of Interest Code in which certain enumerated officials and
5 employees and members of certain enumerated Boards, Commissions, Committees and the Grand Jury are

7 inspection.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all designated employees shall file their Statements of
9 Economic Interest with the Head of their Department or Agency. Upon receipt of the Statements of
10 Economic Interest, the Head of the Department or Agency shall retain the Statements on file with their
11 office, with the exception of the Statement of the Department or Agency Head who shall file his or her
12 own Statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Consultants, Members of Boards,
13 Commissions, Committees and members of the Grand Jury shall file their statements directly with the
14 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Statements shall be filed by April 1 of each year to reflect interests
15 held in the prior calendar year.





BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Political Reform Act, Government Code section 81000, et seq., provides that each governmental agency adopt and maintain a Conflict of Interest Code.

Since 1986, the County has been using the standard Conflict of Interest Code found in California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 18730. Government Code Section 87306.5 requires that in every even year, all local agencies review their codes and make any appropriate amendments to their Conflict of Interest Codes, and the listing of designated positions for employees who must disclose along with the types of disclosure required. The county is considered a local agency under Government Code Section 82041.

The proposed amendment revises and updates the Appendix to the County's Conflict of Interest Code. The Appendix lists the designated positions and the disclosure categories.

The Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) requires that a public hearing be set for amendments to the County's Conflict of Interest Code and recommends a 45-day comment period. Following the 45-day comment period, the public hearing will occur, at which time the Board of Supervisors may adopt the Conflict of Interest Code.

It is recommended that Department Heads provide a signed certificate each year that the employees in their department or agency, whose positions are listed in the code, have timely completed and turned in their 700 Disclosure Forms.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all designated employees shall file their Statements of Economic Interest with the Head of their Department or Agency. Upon receipt of the Statements of Economic Interest, the Head of the Department or Agency shall retain the Statements on file with their office, with the exception of the Statement of the Department or Agency Head who shall file his or her own Statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Consultants, Members of Boards, Commissions, Committees and members of the Grand Jury shall file their statements directly with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Statements shall be filed by April 1 of each year to reflect interests held in the prior calendar year.
