



**Term of Appointment:** Four-year terms commencing immediately and ending June 30, 2021. (Delk replaces Lee Anderson)

Saralyn Delk owns and operates Regulus Ranch, a date farm on which she lives. As a member of the Riverside County Farm Bureau, California Farm Bureau and California Women for Agriculture, Delk will provide an important voice for agriculture on the council.

Rick Hahn has completed a partial term on the council. Hahn has lived in Vista Santa Rosa since 1999 and is a teacher at Saul Martinez Elementary School. Hahn is a full-time resident and plans to remain in the area through retirement. He participated in the initial meetings that led to the creation of Vista Santa Rosa as a separate community. He also worked on the community's design guidelines. Hahn is committed to providing careful thought and consideration for projects and other issues that come before the council and ensuring that design guidelines are implemented.

Richard Fausel has been a member of the Vista Santa Rosa Community Council since October 17, 2006. He remains very active during council meetings and has been voted by his peers to be chairman and vice chairman many times. As the economy recovers and as development in the Vista Santa Rosa area increases, Fausel's insight into previous decisions in the community, especially the Vista Santa Rosa Land Use Plan (June 2008), will provide important consistency and certainty into the future.
