BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated January 27, 2015 (Agenda Item 3-25), the Board of Supervisors authorized Contract No. 14-12-004 between the County of Riverside (County) and RBF Consulting, Inc. The Contract provided for three (3) years of professional engineering services with two-one (1) year extensions with a maximum annual capacity of \$250,000 per Fiscal Year.

RBF Consulting, Inc. merged with Michael Baker International on July 1, 2015 and has legally changed the firm's name to Michael Baker International. The name change will have no impact on the provision of services under the Agreement. The company's corporate address, bank accounts, company management, technical staff and financial personnel remain the same. A new Federal Tax Identification Number (FEIN) and copies of Certificates of Merger from both the State of California and the State of Pennsylvania have been provided to the County.

The full annual maximum capacity of \$250,000 of this contract, for FY 16/17, has been encumbered for work required on the Salt Creek Trail project, which the County is undertaking on behalf of the Riverside County Park & Open Space District.

Work to prepare a Project Initiation Document (PID) was started by a developer in 2006/2007 for the Cherry Valley Boulevard/I-10 Interchange, who retained Michael Baker International (formerly RBF Consulting) to prepare the document, but was never completed due to the economic downturn. Since the County has extensive experience in the development and implementation of interchange projects, the City requested that the County take over the development of the PID and contract with Michael Baker International to conduct the necessary studies, coordinate with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), and finalize the PID for the Cherry Valley Boulevard/I-10 Interchange project. A Cooperative Agreement between the County and the City for the funding of the work has been prepared and is being submitted under a separate agenda item. A Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans has been prepared and will be submitted under a separate agenda item at a later Board agenda meeting.

This 1st Amendment to the Agreement for On-Call Engineering Services between the County of Riverside and Michael Baker International will provide a budget increase of \$250,000 for the

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update and final preparation of the PID for the Cherry Valley Boulevard and Interstate 10 Interchange. The City will fund 100% of the cost to prepare the PID.

County Counsel has approved Amendment No. 1 as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed project will address the need for increased capacity due to recent land development activities in the area and will also enhance public safety and overall driving conditions to the motoring public by improving and updating an antiquated interchange on Interstate 10 at Cherry Valley Boulevard.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

This amendment to Contract No. 14-12-004 will increase the On-Call Engineering Services contract between the County and Michael Baker International from \$250,000 to \$500,000 for FY 16/17 and will be paid by the City of Calimesa. This will bring the total contract amount to \$1,500,000 for work performed by Michael Baker International (formerly RBF Consulting), for various projects. A Cooperative Agreement between the City of Calimesa and the County also appears on this agenda. In addition, the Cooperative Agreement between Caltrans and the County for this project will follow on a future Board meeting.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The County negotiated with Michael Baker International (formerly RBF Consulting) for staff billing rates to remain fixed from January 2015 through June 30, 2017. The billing rates in the contract are within the range of acceptable industry practice for engineering services. Additionally, having worked on the initial Project Study Report in 2006/2007, Michael Baker International can modify their initial work to meet new Caltrans standards cost effectively and expeditiously.



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1st AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

For On-Call Engineering Services

Between County of Riverside - Transportation Department

And Michael Baker International (formerly RBF Consulting)

THIS AMENDMENT (hereinafter the "1st Amendment") to the Agreement is made and entered into as of this 2 4 day of March 2017, by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter the "COUNTY"), and RBF Consulting, Inc. (now MICHAEL BAKER INTERNATIONAL) ((hereinafter "ENGINEER")).

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ENGINEER have entered into an agreement entitled "On-Call General Engineering Services between County of Riverside Transportation Department and RBF Consulting, Inc." that is dated January 27, 2015 (hereinafter the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides the terms and conditions, scope of work, schedule and budget for the performance of professional and technical services necessary to provide on-call engineering services.
- B. Subsequent to execution of the original Agreement, RBF Consulting, Inc. merged with Michael Baker International and is now changing its firm's legal name to Michael Baker International as of July 1, 2015. The company's corporate business address, bank accounts, company management, technical staff and financial personnel remain the same. A new Federal Tax Identification Number (FEIN) has been provided along with Certificates of Merger from both the State of California and the State of Pennsylvania.
- C. The name change will have no impact on the provision of services under the Agreement and Michael Baker International will continue to perform all duties, responsibilities and obligations under the Agreement.
- D. Appendix B Article BI establishes the time period for allowing work assignments to be authorized under the original agreement. The terms and conditions specify that work assignment can be authorized until June 30, 2017 and that the authority to approve and execute work assignments can be modified through one-year supplemental extensions. The agreement allows for two separate one-year extensions.
- E. Appendix C Article CIV establishes the annual maximum capacity not to exceed \$250,000.
- F. The City of Calimesa has requested that the COUNTY, as lead agency on the Cherry Valley/Interstate 10

Interchange project, contract with the ENGINEER through the Agreement to update/modify the Project Initial Documents (PID) originally prepared by the ENGINEER in FY 2006/2007, in order to meet current Caltrans Standards, resulting in a one-time budget increase to the annual maximum capacity of the AGREEMENT in the amount of \$250,000 for FY 2016/2017.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. All references to RBF Consulting, Inc. as appear in the original Agreement shall hereinafter mean and refer to Michael Baker International.
- 2. The authority to complete work assignments under this contract is hereby increased for FY 2016/2017 by the amount of \$250,000 modifying Appendix C • Article CIV of the original agreement on a one-time basis.
- 3. Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.
