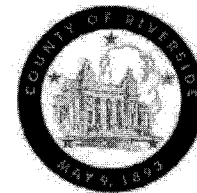



SUBJECT: DEPARTMENT OF WASTE RESOURCES: Approval of Contract Documents for the Construction of the 2017 Closed Sites Improvements Project, District 3, 4, & 5 [\$0 – Department of Waste Resources Enterprise Funds]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3) (General Rule for Exemption), and categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations of Land); and
2. Approve the Contract Documents for the Construction of the 2017 Closed Sites Maintenance and Improvements Project ; and
3. Authorize the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the Riverside County Department of Waste Resources to advertise for bids; and
4. Authorize the General Manager-Chief Engineer to execute change orders as provided by Public Contract Code Section 20142 and approved by County Counsel.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The project covered by this contract is certain construction work affecting the Anza, Beaumont, Double Butte, Edom Hill, Hemet, Homeland, Idyllwild and Badlands Landfills. The major features of this project work include (1) crack seal and seal coat applications to existing asphalt concrete drainage structures as a means to preserve their structural integrity and service life at six landfills; (2) import of rock boulders from a County Transportation quarry pit for use in mitigating trespassing and associated activities at one closed landfill property containing archaeological sites/cultural resources; (3) install a new sedimentation basin to preserve a primary landfill access route and minimize downstream erosion; (4) import and install greenwaste material to preserve the integrity of an existing landfill cover system; and (5) removal and replacement of two asphalt drainage structure sections that now pond as a result of long-term landfill settlement.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings

The Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) (General Rule for Exemption), and categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 Existing Facilities and Section 15304 Minor Alterations of Land. The Project contemplated in this Form 11 involves approval of a contract identifying proposed drainage maintenance and improvements at seven inactive landfills and the active Badlands Landfill. The Contract Documents including Specifications will be advertised, and ultimately, a contractor will be selected to complete the work (under a separate Board action). The work identified in the Contract Documents involves site drainage improvements and repairs, which includes installation of asphalt and concrete drainage structures, and erosion control measures. The site drainage improvement activities occur within existing landfill disturbance areas. The drainage improvements involve no expansion of approved uses. This work would not have a direct, indirect, or cumulatively significant effect on the environment. A Notice of Exemption (NOE) to this effect will be filed with the County Clerk upon Project approval.
