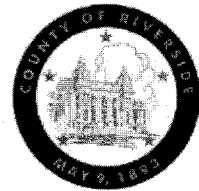

**SUBJECT:** Naming of Education Center at Lamb Canyon Landfill

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors join me in support of naming the Lamb Canyon landfill Education Center after our esteemed colleague, Supervisor Marion Ashley:

**BACKGROUND:** The Education Center is currently being constructed at the Lamb Canyon landfill at a strategically situated observation point that provides 360 degree views of western Riverside County. The facility is designed to provide a safe and central location for the frequent site tours provided by the Department of Waste Resources staff to school groups, industry leaders, dignitaries, the grand jury and other interested parties. The facility consists of an approximately 1,200 square foot concrete pad covered by a solid aluminum cover, with recycled concrete base material in the parking area. Informational, interpretive signs (made of environmentally friendly material) will provide attendees with interesting facts about landfills; how they are constructed, operate, and monitored, what materials are and can be recycled, and the natural resources that are protected. Lighting and accessory power will be provided by solar panels to encourage sustainable living practices. Additionally, a large salvaged landfill dozer will be on display to safely allow tour groups a close-up view in order to grasp the scale of trash handling equipment.

The facility will allow the County to showcase one of its major regional landfill assets at a safe and permanent location, high above the landfill where one can view the operation, while providing an impressive view of the Riverside County landscape.
