

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BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Board of Supervisors adopted Riverside County Ordinance No. 525.5 effective April 16, 1998. Section 2 of the ordinance established a five (5) member Board of Examiners, appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The members are appointed for three (3) year terms, not to exceed a collective appointment of ten (10) years.

The Ordinance specifies that Board members are from certain occupations. Jared Nerio and Max Mendoza are two representatives from the domestic water supply industry. Roland Hazzard is a member of the plumbing industry. Heidi Barrios and Christina Quintero are two representatives from the Department of Environmental Health.

The Board of Examiners meets quarterly to test and certify individuals to inspect backflow assemblies throughout the County of Riverside.
