BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside Ending Homeless Fund - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the "Walk to End Homelessness" program which will provide essential resources to homeless individuals that help promote sustainability of housing and employment.
- 2. University Homeless Women Shelter - \$1,000** Funding will be used to provide services to homeless women and families such as food, temporary shelter, emergency medical needs, bus tickets, infant and child needs, clothing, toiletries, counseling, etc.
- 3. Friends of the Woodcrest Library - \$2,000** funding will be used to support their Summer Reading program "Read by Design" which provides educational and enrichment programs for children in the First District. A portion of these funds will also be used for the Cookies with Santa event held at the Woodcrest Library.
- 4. Muslim Family Foundation of the Inland Empire - \$500** funding will be used to support the 4th Annual Family Symposium, a free event held on April 29, 2017, which will provide community resources and education for families living in Riverside County.
