

BACKGROUND:

Summary

In August 2014, the City of Jurupa Valley (City) successfully competed to receive Active Transportation Program (ATP) funds for the Troth Street sidewalk improvement project which proposes to provide a safe pedestrian route between Jurupa Road and 54th Street, to travel to and from the Troth Street Elementary School. Since the City does not have authority to administer state and federally funded projects, the County of Riverside (County) was designated as the lead agency to complete the project, including construction administration through a Service Agreement approved by the Board of Supervisors on March 24, 2015 (Agenda Item 3-38).

The proposed improvements on Troth Street will include new curb, gutter and sidewalk on the east side of the street between Jurupa Road and 58th Street and will extend the limits of the existing sidewalk on the west side of the street between Jurupa Road and 54th Street. ADA compliant ramps will be installed at all the intersections along the project and enhanced crosswalk improvements at the intersection of Troth Street and 56th Street will be provided, including solar LED flashers with pedestrian push buttons.

The project includes minor reconstruction of the existing pavement to match the proposed curb elevations and minor road widening of an additional 2-feet for the proposed curb and gutter.

The allocation of State construction funds by the California Transportation Commission (CTC) is expected to be approved at its March 16, 2017 meeting.

A funding agreement between the City of Jurupa Valley and the County of Riverside, which will provide funding by the City, will be brought forth prior to or concurrent with the award of this project.

The County Transportation Department desires Board authorization to begin advertising for bids following the March 16, 2017 CTC meeting, subject to CTC approval of funds.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel, and environmental clearance has been completed and posted with the County Clerk by the City of Jurupa Valley. This environmental document for the project was approved by the City and the Notice of Exemption was filed on January 29, 2015.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will improve pedestrian safety, reduce traffic congestion, and enhance operational efficiency around Troth Street Elementary School that is consistent with the City's General Plan Circulation Element.

The work is scheduled to begin in Summer 2017. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction and will take approximately two months to complete. The Contractor will be required to coordinate the construction with the City of Jurupa Valley, Jurupa Unified School District and the Postmaster for mail delivery.

Additional Fiscal Information

In addition to City of Jurupa Valley local funds, this sidewalk project will be receiving State ATP funds. The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$680,000. Construction is expected to finish in FY 2016/2017.

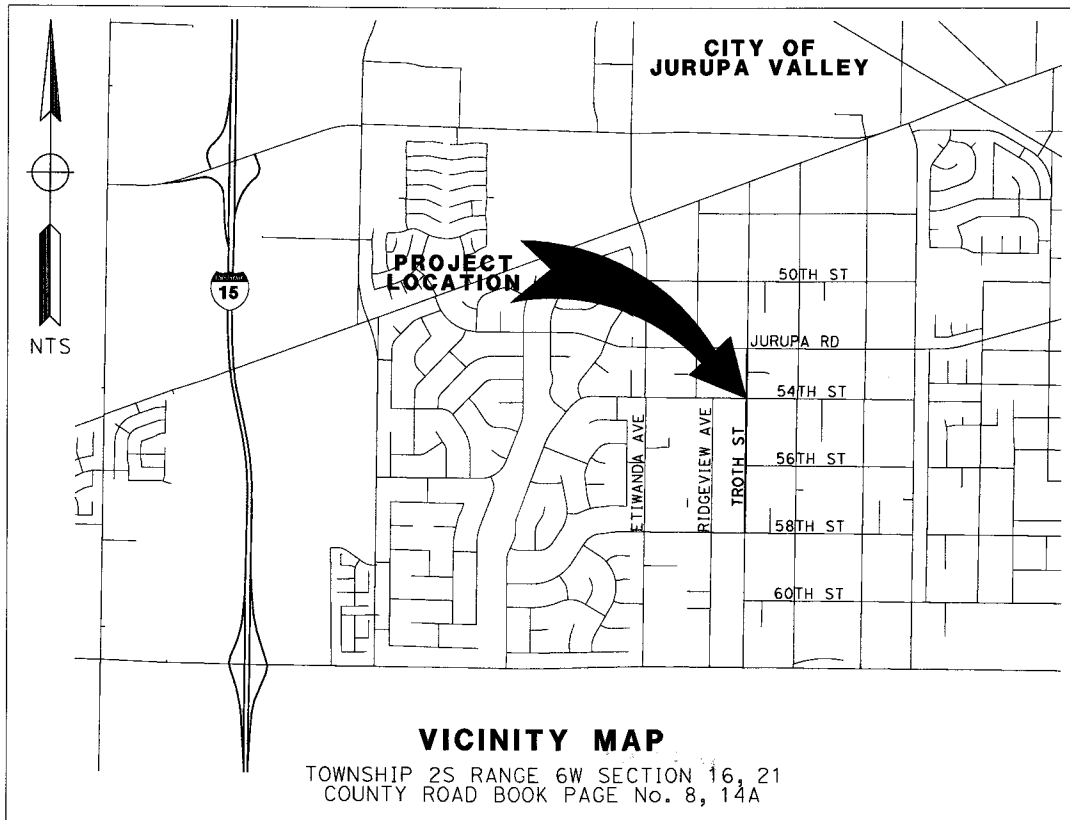
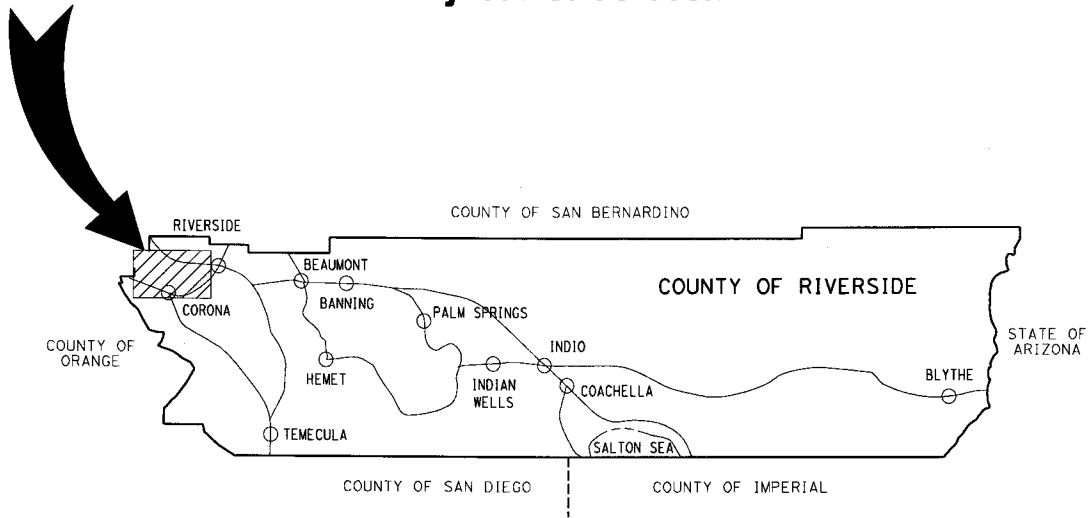

This project will enhance the safety of all pedestrians entering and exiting this school zone while involving negligible or no expansion of the existing use. In accordance with Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered a covered activity, and are not subject to survey or mitigation requirements outside Criteria Areas and Public/Quasi Public Lands.</p> <p>The City of Jurupa Valley Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposals qualify for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines as set forth in section 15301(c).</p>


