

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. Santa Rosa Plateau Nature Education Foundation - \$1,000 the funding will be used for transportation of students to field study sites on the Reserve and at local watershed areas. Approximately 3,000 students from Riverside County Third District participate with the Santa Rosa Plateau education program.
2. Women Wonder Writers - \$1,000 funding will be utilized for a Sheroes Conference for San Jacinto middle school and high school students. The conference will focus on breaking the cycle of abuse and victimization of children through creative intervention and mentorships.
3. MS Fitness Challenge - \$1,000 the funding will be used for the Murrieta / Temecula Fitness Challenge Winter 2017. The program offers training and education to individuals who are impacted with the disease of Multiple Sclerosis.
4. Friends of San Jacinto Mountain County Parks - \$500 the funding will help to sponsor the 8th Annual Lemon Lily Festival in Idyllwild. The festival is to foster an appreciation for the threatened native lily, Lillium parryi in Idyllwild.
