



BACKGROUND:

Summary

California Elections Code §§ 10002, 10402, and 10403 allow jurisdictions to request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct elections by submitting a resolution requesting these services. The City of Riverside has complied with this requirement and has requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct its election. The department has the resources to provide these services. The County will receive reimbursements from the jurisdiction based on associated direct costs of conducting their election.

Registered voters in the City of Riverside will have the opportunity to vote for Councilmembers of Wards 2, 4, and 6 listed on the attached resolution.

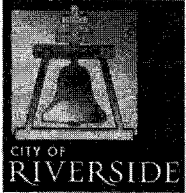
Additional Fiscal Information

RESOLUTION NO. 23136

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING
4 NOTICE OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 6,
5 2017, TO BE CONDUCTED WHOLLY BY MAIL-IN BALLOT IN THE
6 CITY OF RIVERSIDE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MEMBER
7 OF THE CITY COUNCIL FROM THE SECOND, FOURTH AND SIXTH
8 WARDS OF SAID CITY OF RIVERSIDE.

9 The City Council of the City of Riverside does hereby resolve as follows:

10 Section 1: That in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Riverside
11 and the Constitution and election laws of the State of California, a General Municipal Election be
12 held and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of Riverside on June 6,
13 2017, for the purpose of electing three members of the City Council of the City of Riverside. The
14 members of the City Council shall be from the even-numbered wards of the City of Riverside as
15 established by the City Council.

16 Section 2: That no polling places will be secured as said election is to be conducted
17 wholly by mail-in ballot. Official ballots will be mailed together with the sample ballot
18 pamphlet and a postage prepaid envelope for return of the official ballot. Voted ballots must be
19 returned to the Registrar of Voters Office or to one of the drop-off locations, at least one of
20 which shall be located in Ward Two, Ward Four and Ward Six. Voted ballots must be returned
21 no later than 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday June 6, 2017, or be postmarked on or before Election Day
22 and received no later than three (3) days after the Election Day to be counted.

23 Section 3: That the purpose of holding said General Municipal Election there shall be
24 and hereby are established consolidated voting precincts consisting of a consolidation of the
25 regular precincts in the City of Riverside established for the holding of state and county elections
26 as said regular election precincts exist on the date of this resolution.

27 Section 4: That the form and contents of the ballots to be used at said election shall be as
28 provided by law.

Section 5: That in accordance with Section 10002 of the Elections Code, the Board of
Supervisors of Riverside County are hereby requested to consent to the Riverside County
Registrar of Voters rendering election services to the City of Riverside as may be requested by

1 the City Clerk of said City, the County of Riverside to be reimbursed in full for such services as
2 are performed.


3 Section 6: That the City Clerk shall have charge of all City elections pursuant to
4 Riverside City Charter section 703(f).

5 Section 7: That the City Clerk is hereby designated the "Elections Official" for the
6 purposes of this election pursuant to Elections Code section 320(b).

7 Section 8: That based upon the foregoing authority, the City Clerk shall have charge
8 of this election and shall make all determinations necessary to conducting this election.


9 Section 9: That the City Clerk of said City shall receive the canvass of the General
10 Municipal Election and shall certify the results to the City Council, as required by law.



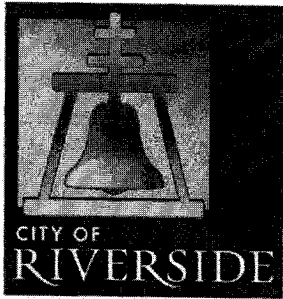

GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION - RESOLUTION
The City Council (1) adopted a resolution calling the General Municipal Election to be held June 6, 2017, to elect Members of the City Council for Wards 2, 4, and 6, and consenting to the Registrar of Voters rendering election services to the City as requested by the City Clerk with the County of Riverside to be reimbursed in full for the services; (2) directed the City Clerk to permit electronic distribution of Candidate Statements of Qualifications pursuant to Elections Code Section 13307 for the June 6, 2017, election and all future elections; and (3) continued the practice of requiring the candidates to pay the costs for publication of Candidate Statements of Qualifications; whereupon, the title having been read and further reading waived, Resolution No. 23136 of the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, Ordering, Calling, Providing for and Giving Notice of a General Municipal Election to be Held June 6, 2017, to be Conducted Wholly by Mail-In Ballot in the City of Riverside for the Purpose of Electing a Member of the City Council from the Second, Fourth and Sixth Wards of Said City of Riverside, was presented and adopted.
