



BACKGROUND:

Summary

1. The Desert Recreation District will be providing summer activities in the eastern Coachella Valley. Many of the families from these communities are low income and have few options for family recreation. The summer activities will include programs for elementary school students, teenagers and senior residents. CID funds will be used toward the cost of program supplies, snacks, craft supplies, marketing cost, and transportation to the DRD pools.

2. The Reynaldo J. Carreon MD Foundation will host its annual Dr. Carreon Foundation Scholarship Awards Banquet. For the past 25 years, the Dr. Carreon Foundation has awarded scholarships to assist youth who come from disadvantaged backgrounds. This event will help benefit from these scholarships.
