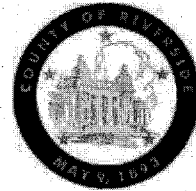



4. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A."



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated January 17, 2017 (Agenda Item 3-39), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Slurry Seal Project at various locations in the 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts.

The slurry seal treatments are provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The slurry seal treatments seal small cracks, restore lost flexibility of the pavement surface and helps preserve underlying pavement structure. This project includes various roads located within the 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts of the County of Riverside (County). The specific roads are listed in Attachment "1".

This project proposes Slurry Seal, Cape Seal or Microsurfacing surface treatments based on the existing pavement conditions.

The Slurry Seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregates, water and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes road cleaning, crack repairs, application of slurry seal treatment, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times, at specified intervals, after the slurry has been applied.

The Cape Seal treatment adds a layer of "chips" or small crushed rock (screenings), and the slurry seal is placed over the chips and acts as a "wearing course" in areas of high vehicular traffic.

The Microsurfacing treatment uses a Microsurfacing Emulsion that does not rely on the sun or heat to cure and can be driven on in a much shorter time. The emulsion is "scrubbed" into the pavement with brushes; however, "chips" and slurry seal are not placed over this treatment.

During the advertisement period, two addenda's were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addenda was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The County Transportation Department recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$1,540,908:

Base Bid Schedule: Slurry Seal Project

Alternate Bid Schedule 1: Construction of Concrete Curb Ramps and Installation of Rumble Strip

Alternate bid schedule 1 is included in the contract for the construction of six concrete curb ramps and the installation of ground-in rumble strips along the centerline.

Curb ramps will be constructed at the South East and North East corners of Country Club Drive and Washington Street, South West corner of Country Club Drive and Starlight Lane, and 3 of the corners of Reche Canyon Rd and Reche Vista Drive.

The installation of a ground-in centerline rumble stripe will take place along portions of Reche Canyon Road, Reche Vista Drive, Redlands Blvd, Grapefruit Boulevard, and Country Club to alert drivers when they stray from the lanes.

The contractor American Asphalt South, Inc. is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Project Numbers: C6-0009 (District 4), C6-0010 (District 5)

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The slurry seal, cape seal, and microsurfacing treatments will extend the life of the roads and reduce the need for resurfacing, which is ten times more costly. The construction is anticipated to begin in the Summer of 2017 and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to American Asphalt South, Inc. for the total amount of \$1,540,908. The slurry seal contract is fully funded with Gas Tax/HUTA. The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes contract award amount and other associated costs.

No General funds will be used for this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Four bids were received on February 8, 2017, ranging from \$1,540,908 to \$2,181,043. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

The lowest responsible bid was submitted by American Asphalt South, Inc. in the amount of \$1,540,908 which is \$126,391 (7.6%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

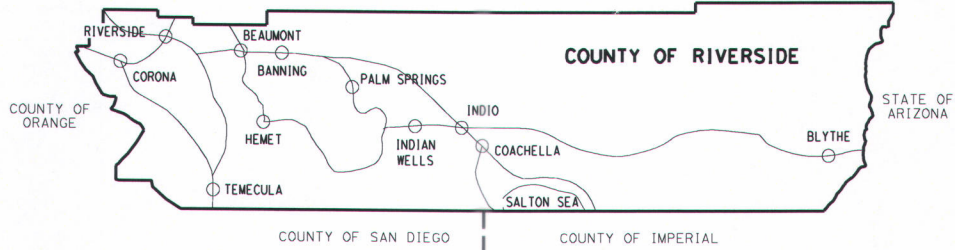

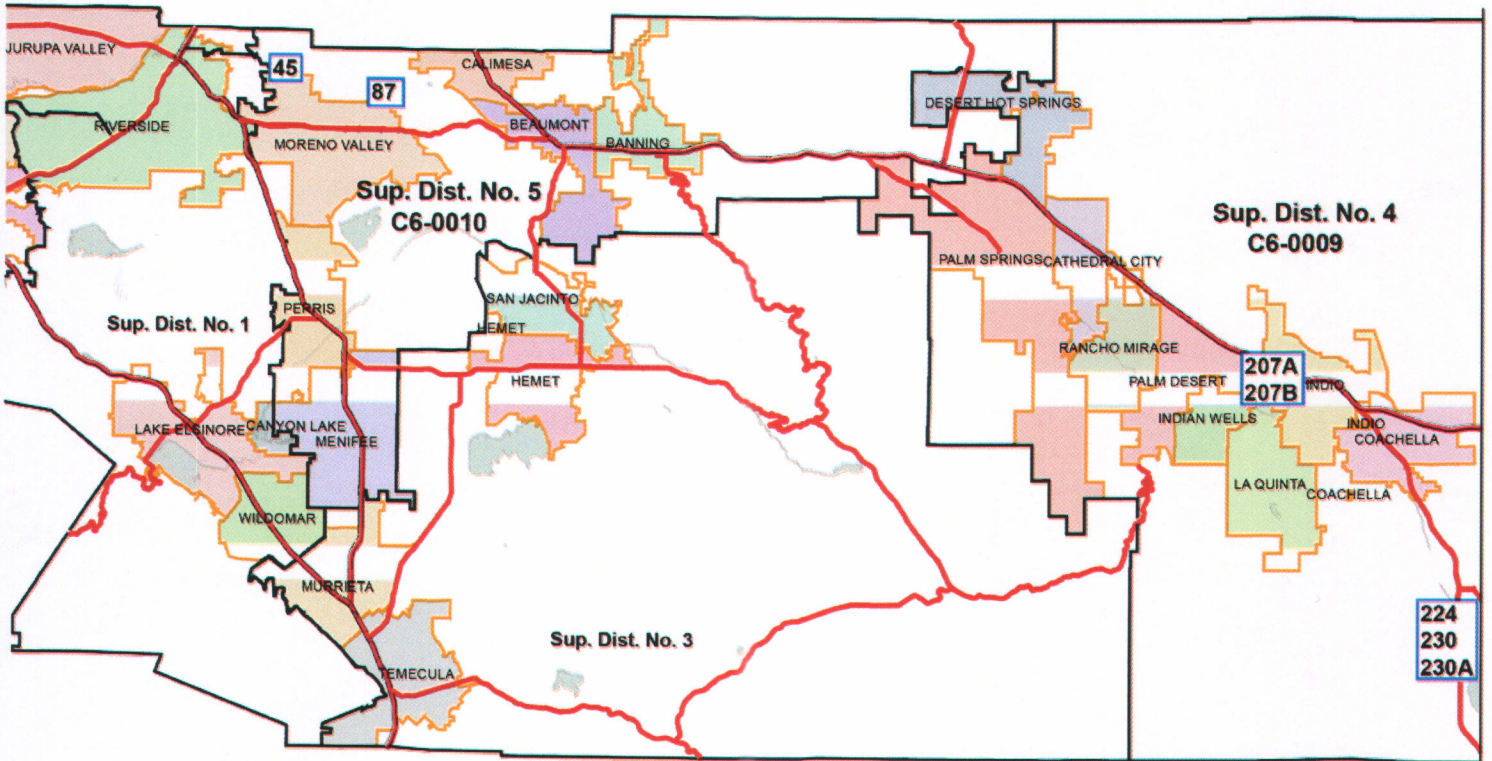

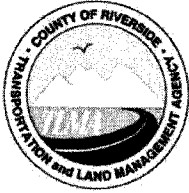

Item 3: Liquidated Damages. Refer to section entitled "LIQUIDATED DAMAGES" on pages 2 and 3 of the special provisions.

- Delete the last paragraph on page 2 of the special provisions.

~~Unless otherwise allowed by the Engineer, the Contractor may perform concurrent Chip Seal (Cape Seal) work on a maximum of four (4) project sites at one time. Chip Seal (Cape Seal) work on the project sites scheduled for work shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Engineer. The Contractor shall not start work on other project sites until directed to do so by the Engineer~~

- Add the following paragraphs:

Striping and Pavement Marking Removal

Striping and pavement markings shall be removed no earlier than 5 calendar days before the slurry, microsurfacing, or chip seal (cape seal) application.

Contractor shall be assessed Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$500 per calendar day, for each street that the striping and pavement markers are removed, and the Contractor fails to apply the respective seal treatment.

- Refer to Subsection 'Thermoplastic Crosswalk and Pavement Marking' on page 3.

The liquidated damages in subsection 'Thermoplastic Crosswalk and Pavement Marking' are also applicable to all **Traffic Striping** that is not restored no earlier than five-calendar days and no later than ten-calendar days after the slurry application.

- Add the following paragraph:

Microsurfacing

Contractor shall be assessed Liquidated Damages in the amount of **\$500 per calendar day for each street** that the Contractor fails to complete all Microsurfacing seal treatment within five (5) calendar days after the commencement of the street microsurfacing seal.

- Item 4: Remove Painted And Thermoplastic Pavement Markings And Pavement Markers.** Refer to section entitled 'REMOVE PAINTED AND THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND PAVEMENT MARKERS' on pages 21 and 22 of the special provisions.

Delete the fourth paragraph in section 'ROUT AND SEAL RANDOM CRACKS/FILL POTHOLE'S' and replace it with the following paragraph:

Crosswalk lines, pavement markings, and all traffic striping shall be restored by the Contractor no earlier than five-calendar days and no later than ten-calendar days after the slurry and cape seal application. The restoration of the pavement delineations for microsurfacing application shall be in conformance to ORDER OF WORK of these Special Provisions.

- Item 5: SLURRY SEAL (Type I and Type II).** Refer to section entitled 'SLURRY SEAL (Type I and Type II)' on pages 23 through 28 of the special provisions.

- The application rates are revised on the fourth paragraph on page 24 as follows:

The total areas in Slurry Seal Quantity Tables in the appendix, shall be considered as approximate only and no guarantee is made as to the accuracy.

- Item 6: Chip Seal (Cape Seal).** Refer to section entitled 'CHIP SEAL (CAPE SEAL)' on pages 28 through 31 of the special provisions.

- Delete the last paragraph on page 28 of the special provisions.

~~Unless otherwise allowed by the Engineer, the Contractor may perform concurrent Chip Seal (Cape Seal) work on a maximum of four (4) project sites at one time. Chip Seal (Cape Seal) work on the project sites scheduled for work shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Engineer. The Contractor shall not start work on other project sites until directed to do so by the Engineer.~~

- Item 7: Other Additional Requirements.** Refer to section entitled 'OTHER ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS' on pages 32 through 38 of the special provisions.

- On page 33, delete the letter J requirement for distributor trucks.

j. ~~Scrub broom conforming to subsection "Scrub Brooms."~~

- Delete the Measurement and Payment paragraph found on top of page 38 and replace it with the following paragraph:

Payment for Additional Requirements mentioned in this section shall be considered as included in the contract unit price paid per Ton for Slurry Seal Type I and/or Type II, Microsurfacing, and per square yard for Screenings and shall be considered as full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for

placing screenings, rolling, sweeping, finishing, maintenance, and performing necessary cleanups as specified in these Special Provisions and as directed by the Engineer.

Item 8: Microsurfacing. Refer to section entitled 'MICROSURFACING' on pages 38 through 47 of the special provisions.

- Delete the Aggregate Grading table on page 39 and replace it with the following table:

- Refer to subsection entitled 'MIXING AND SPREADING EQUIPMENT' on pages 43 through 45 of the special provisions. Delete subsections • General, • Continuous Self Loading Mixing Machine, and • Mixer-Spreader Machines, on pages 43 and 44, and replace them with the following special provisions:

General

Mixing and spreading equipment for micro-surfacing must proportion asphaltic emulsion, water, aggregate, and any set-control additives by volume and mix them in mixer spreader trucks. Mixing and spreading equipment shall be approved by the Engineer prior to the start of the Work.

Mixer-Spreader Trucks

Mixer-spreader trucks shall be continuous-flow mixers conforming to 302-4.2.2 modified as necessary to be capable of producing and placing microsurfacing. Trucks shall have sufficient storage capacity for aggregate, MSE, mineral filler, water and additives to maintain an adequate supply to the proportioning controls. Aggregate feeders shall be connected directly to the drive on the emulsion pump. The drive shaft of the aggregate feeder shall be equipped with a revolution counter reading to the nearest one-tenth of a revolution.

The identifying number of each machine shall be a minimum of 3 inches in height, located on the front and rear of the vehicle.

The mixer trucks shall be equipped with a fines feeder to add cement or granular aluminum sulfate.

The microsurfacing mixture shall be spread by means of a spreader box. However, when wheel path depressions have a cross section that is deformed 1/2 inch or more, the individual wheel paths shall first be filled utilizing a wheel path depression (rut) box.

- Refer to subsection 'PLACEMENT' on pages 45 and 46. Delete the second paragraph of subsection 'PLACEMENT' on page 45 and replace it with the following:

Microsurfacing shall not be placed when either the ambient or pavement temperature is below 50°F or when ambient temperature exceeds 100°F or during unsuitable weather. Microsurfacing shall not be placed if rain is imminent or if there is the possibility that there will be freezing temperatures within 24 hours.

- Add the following paragraph after the Microsurfacing Spread Rates table on page 46:

Microsurfacing shall follow the same placement procedures similar to the procedures of the SLURRY SEAL (TYPE I and TYPE II) of these Special Provisions, including, but not limited to, the minimum truck mixers required, placement schedules, and the maximum tonnage of slurry placed per day.

- Item 9: Asphalt Seal Coat.** The special provision entitled "ASPHALTIC EMULSION – FOG SEAL COAT," found on pages 47 and 48, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following "ASPHALT SEAL COAT" special provisions:

ASPHALT SEAL COAT:

Asphalt seal coat shall consist of mixing asphaltic emulsion, aggregate, polymer and water and spreading the mixture on pavement surfaces. Asphalt seal coat shall be applied as shown on the plans and in conformance these special provisions.

Asphaltic emulsion shall be either Grade SS1h or CSS1h and shall conform to the provisions in Section 94, "Asphaltic Emulsions," of the Standard Specifications, except that in Tables 1 and 2, the values for penetration at 25°C, in the tests on residue from distillation, shall be a minimum of 20 to a maximum of 60. Clay stabilized emulsion with a solids content of not less than 45 percent by mass may be used.

Mineral aggregate components shall be clean, hard, durable, uncoated particles that are free from decomposed materials, organic materials and other deleterious substances. The percentage composition, by mass, of the aggregate shall be 100 percent passing the No. 16 sieve.

At least 10 days prior to their intended use, the Contractor shall furnish samples of aggregates from the source the Contractor proposes to use for the project. The samples shall have been processed in a manner representative of that for the material to be used in the work.

Polymer additive shall be a commercial quality polymer formulated for the purpose intended. The Contractor shall submit the manufacturer's product data information for the proposed polymer at least 10 days prior to use.

Water shall be potable and of such quality that the water will not separate from the

emulsion before the material is placed in the work.

Oil seal primer shall be a quick-drying emulsion with suitable admixtures manufactured specifically for the purpose of isolating the asphalt seal coat from residual oils, petroleum grease, and gasoline stained pavements. The properties of the oil seal primer shall be compatible with the new asphalt seal coat materials. The Contractor shall submit the manufacturer's product data information of the material proposed for use at least 10 days prior to use.

Crack sealant shall be either a modified asphalt material or a specialty prepared crack sealing material conforming to the requirements in ASTM Designation: D 1190, D 3405 or D 5078.

At least 10 days before asphalt seal coat placement, the Contractor shall submit to the Engineer for approval a laboratory report of tests and proposed mix designs for the specific materials to be used on the project.

A laboratory capable of performing the applicable tests shall perform the tests and mix design. The proposed mixture shall conform to the following requirements of the following tests:

* Weigh 10 grams of homogenous product into a previously tared, small ointment can. Place in constant temperature oven at 165°C ±5°C for 90 minutes ±3 minutes. Cool, reweigh and calculate non-volatile components as a percent of the original weight.

The laboratory that performs the tests and mix designs shall prepare a signed report that contains the following: results of the tests on individual materials, comparisons of the test results to the specifications, and the amount of water that is allowed to be added on site. Previous laboratory reports covering the same materials may be accepted, provided that the reports were prepared during the same calendar year.

No substitution of other mix designs for asphalt seal coat material will be permitted unless the materials proposed for substitution are tested and a laboratory report is submitted for the substituted design as specified above.

The Contractor shall furnish a Certificate of Compliance to the Engineer in conformance with the provisions in Section 6-1.07, "Certificates of Compliance" of the Standard Specifications. The certificate shall certify that the asphalt seal coat material, conforms to these special provisions.

Asphalt seal coat mixture shall be produced by uniformly blending asphaltic emulsion,

aggregate, water, and admixtures in a central plant capable of producing a finished product conforming to these special provisions. Components shall be measured by electronic or mechanical controls that consistently proportion the additives. Blending the admixtures with the base asphaltic emulsion shall be by mechanical means to provide a uniform mixture.

Asphalt seal coat shall be stored in a tank equipped with power driven mixing or agitation equipment capable of keeping the stored material thoroughly and uniformly mixed. The stored material shall be protected from freezing in cold weather conditions.

Asphalt seal coat shall contain a minimum of 2 percent polymer by volume of the undiluted asphaltic emulsion material. The polymer shall be added on site and verified by the Engineer.

Water may be added at the project site in conformance with the manufacturer's recommendations for consistency and spreadability, but shall not exceed 15 percent by volume.

Pavement surfaces to receive asphalt seal coat shall be cleaned of oil and grease spots, dirt, clay, dust, and other deleterious materials that might adversely affect bonding of the seal coat. Cleaning shall be done by air blowing, vacuum, mechanical sweeper, washing, or other methods approved by the Engineer. Solvents shall not be used for cleaning pavement.

Prior to surface preparation, cracks shall be cleaned and sealed with crack sealant. The properties of the crack sealant shall be such as to be compatible with the asphalt seal coat material. Cracks shall be cleaned by high pressure air blasting or any other method that leaves a clean dry surface. Excess sealant shall be removed with a squeegee. Prior to proceeding with subsequent seal coat or tack coat, the Contractor shall obtain the Engineer's approval that the crack sealant is sufficiently cured to accept the subsequent materials.

Cracks wider than one inch shall be filled with a fine aggregate hot, dense graded asphalt concrete conforming to Section 39 of the California Standard Specification for 3/8" Maximum Asphalt Concrete.

When detergents are used in the washing method for cleaning the pavement surface, the pavement shall be thoroughly rinsed with water before application of the asphalt seal coat.

Detergents shall not be used that will adversely affect the pavement surface or the seal coat, as determined by the Engineer. The surface shall not have standing water prior to the application of the seal coat.

After cleaning the existing pavement, remaining oil and grease spots shall be sealed with oil seal primer. The oil seal primer shall be applied in conformance with the manufacturer's recommendations.

Areas where oil or grease has penetrated the existing asphalt concrete, and cleaning, and applying oil seal primer or tack coat are insufficient to produce an acceptable surface to receive the seal coat shall be repaired as directed by the Engineer.

Application of the asphalt seal coat shall be performed by mechanical means using rubber faced squeegees, brooms, distributor bars, spray wands, any combination of these methods, or other techniques approved by the Engineer.

Asphalt seal coat material sampled at the project site shall be sealed within 30 minutes of placement and shall be the finished, undiluted material.

Immediately prior to application of the asphalt seal coat, the pavement surface shall be dampened, as directed by the Engineer. A distributor truck or other equipment approved by the Engineer shall be used to apply the water. The surface shall not have any standing water prior to application of the sealant.

The asphalt seal coat shall be applied in two applications and shall be uniform and free flowing, free of lumps and other inconsistencies. If, after the addition of the maximum allowable water volume, the mixture does not produce a seal coat as specified, the seal coat will be rejected and shall be removed, at the Contractor's expense, from the site in conformance with the provisions in Section 7-1.13, "Disposal of Material Outside the Highway Right of Way" of the Standard Specifications. Replacement asphalt seal coat, conforming to the special provisions, shall be furnished and applied.

The asphalt seal coat shall be thoroughly dry prior to application of subsequent coats.

Asphalt seal coat shall be applied uniformly in a continuous manner so that no ridges or uncoated areas shall exist. **Asphalt seal coat shall be applied in 2 coats at a total rate of 0.30 to 0.40 gallons per square yard, not including added water.**

Asphalt seal coat shall not be applied when the ambient temperature is less than 55°F or the surface temperature is less than 60°F. Asphalt seal coat shall not be applied within 24 hours of rain or within 24 hours prior to forecasted rain, freezing temperatures, during rain, or when the surface contains standing water. The Contractor shall notify the Engineer to inactivate the irrigation control system not less than 5 working days prior to applying the seal coat. Irrigation watering will be kept off the area to be seal coated for at least 24 hours prior to and at least 24 hours after the application of the asphalt seal coat.

Upon completion of the final application, the area shall be protected from traffic or equipment for a period of not less than 24 hours.

Striping, if any, shall be applied only after the asphalt seal coat has thoroughly dried.

Method of Payment

The contract price paid per square yard for Asphalt Seal Coat used shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor and material, tools and doing all the required work. Full compensation for crack sealant shall be considered as included in the contract unit price paid per square yard for asphalt seal coat and no separate payment will be made therefor.

Item 10: Obstructions - Concrete Encased Valves Covers, Manholes Covers. Refer to section 'OBSTRUCTIONS' on page 55 of the special provisions. The following Special Provisions are added and made a part hereby:

Contractor shall protect existing concrete encased valves covers and/or manholes covers. Where Chip Seal (Cape Seal) is applied, the Contractor shall stop "chips" or screenings a minimum of 12 inches from the edge of concrete encasement. The slurry shall be applied to provide a smooth transition to the edge of concrete encasement.

Before commencing the sealing operations, all concrete encased valves and/or manholes covers shall be covered by thoroughly covering the surface with an appropriate adhesive and oiled or plastic paper. No adhesive material shall be permitted to cover, seal or fill the joint between the frame and cover of the structure. Covers are to be uncovered and cleaned by the end of the same work day.

Item 11: Index. Refer to 'INDEX' section on page 57 and 58 of the special provisions. The INDEX section is deleted.

Item 12: Microsurface 3 update to Mircosurface 2. Refer plans sheets/pages 03, 04, 07, 08, and 08A of the plans.

Contractors are advised to delete and replace the Microsurface 3 name with **Microsurface 2** in their copy of the project plans/exhibits.
