



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Palm Desert has offered to donate a 1997 Ford F350 E-One Ambulance, to Riverside County Fire Department. Once title is transferred, Riverside County Fire Department will be responsible for the cost of maintenance and repair of the vehicle. The vehicle is operational and is currently at Ben Clark Training Center. This vehicle will be used for EMS Training at Ben Clark Training Center.

The transfer is beneficial for the Riverside County Fire Department as well as the surrounding Cities and Unincorporated areas. This vehicle will be used at Ben Clark Training Center (BCTC) EMS for training purposes. The transfer of title will ensure that the vehicle will be available for the training of the students and staff attending the training center.

The vehicle is identified as:


Additional Fiscal Information
