

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Coachella Valley Volunteers in Medicine (CVVIM) clinic serves the uninsured and low-income patients with medical and dental services since 2010. This is the only no-charge clinic in the Coachella Valley and in Riverside County. CVVIM clinic has suffered from vandalism to its facility, which requires some repairs and addition of lighting fixtures to ensure the safety of patients, staff and volunteers. Additionally, CVVIM is seeking funds to pursue a marketing project that will increase their volunteer, donor and patient base. The funds will be used as follows, \$7,000 for the "Improving Safety and Security at CVVIM" project and \$3,000 for the "Increased Marketing for Volunteer and Donor Development" project.
