SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 857.1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 857 REGARDING THE BUSINESS STORM WATER COMPLIANCE PROGRAM

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code section 25124(b). A certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 857.1 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California, 92501.

Ordinance No. 857.1 amends Ordinance No. 857 in its entirety regarding the County's Business Storm Water Compliance Program. It is the intent of the County of Riverside to comply with directives of the Clean Water Act and the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Permits ("MS4 Permit") for the Santa Ana, Santa Margarita, and Whitewater watersheds so as to protect water quality in Riverside County in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the people of Riverside County through the program set forth in the ordinance. The local regional water quality control boards require an inspection and inventory of all existing commercial and industrial businesses in the County, and prioritization as to the type of business and potential threat to water quality, specifically stated in Sections XI and VI of the Santa Ana Region MS4 Permit, Section F.1.(b) of the Whitewater Region MS4 permit, and Section II. E-5 of the Santa Margarita Region MS4 permit. Section 4 of the ordinance states which types of businesses are exempt from the County's Business Storm Water Compliance Program. Section 5 of the ordinance includes the County's Business Storm Water Compliance Program registration requirements, including the \$45 registration fee, \$30 renewal fee, and \$30 business name change fee. Section 6 of the ordinance identifies the business inspection priorities and categories, as well as the inspection fee of \$400 and enforcement fee of \$225. Ordinance No. 857.1, amending Ordinance No. 857, would become effective sixty days after its adoption.
