

BACKGROUND: Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Habitat for Humanity Inland Valley – donation will be used for the improvement of projects for the surrounding areas of the City of Menifee. The goal of the Habitats involvement is to serve the low-income senior population in Menifee impacted by substandard living conditions by providing exterior home repairs that would otherwise be inaccessible to them. Support will also go to their housing affordability programs for all within the surrounding community by providing traditional new builds and restoring older homes.

2. Perris Valley Chamber of Commerce – will be utilizing their support for their operations and services that will help promote economic development and provided for small business resources as well as community programs.
