RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the Slurry Seal Projects at various locations in 1st, 2nd and 3rd Districts; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 12, 2017 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The slurry seal treatment is provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The slurry seal treatment seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and helps preserve underlying pavement structure. This project includes various roads located within the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Supervisorial Districts. The specific roads are listed in "Attachment 1".

This project proposes Slurry Seal, Cape Seal or Microsurfacing surface treatments based on the existing pavement conditions.

The Slurry Seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregates, water and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes road cleaning, crack repairs, application of slurry seal treatment, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times, at specified intervals, after the slurry has been applied.

The Cape Seal treatment adds a layer of "chips" or small crushed rock (screenings), and the slurry seal is placed over the chips and acts as a "wearing course" in areas of higher vehicles traffic.

The Microsurfacing treatment uses a microsurfacing emulsion that does not rely on the sun or heat to cure and can be driven on in a much shorter time after its application. The emulsion is "scrubbed" into the pavement with brushes; however, "chips" and slurry seal are not placed over this treatment.

Additional work includes five existing access concrete curb ramps which will be reconstructed to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

The County of Riverside (County) Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive bid of the sum of all alternates.

On January 31, 2017 by minute item 3.22, the Board of Supervisors Adopted Resolution 2017-017, Notice of Intent to Accept Portions of Route 74 in the Meadowbrook and Good Hope Areas into the

County Highway System, Adopted Resolution No. 2017-018, Notice of Intent to Accept Portions of Route 74 and Convey the Relinquished Road Right of Way to the City of Lake Elsinore, Adopted Resolution No. 2017-019, Consenting to the Relinquishment of a Portion of Route 74 in the Meadowbrook and Good Hope Areas and Joint Relinquishment of Adjoining Portions of Route 74 to the County of Riverside and City of Lake Elsinore approved the Relinquishment Agreement between the County and California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The Relinquishment was approved by the California Transportation Commission (CTC) at its March 15-16, 2017 meeting. In order to preserve the pavement condition of what will be the County of Riverside's portion of Route 74, a slurry seal treatment is necessary. Including the slurry seal of Route 74, as an alternate bid, schedule provides efficiencies and allows confirmation of relinquishment prior to awarding a construction contract that may include Route 74.

The projects also propose to apply seal treatment to an approximate 1.5 miles segment of Via Volcano from Sierra Elena Road to Avocado Mesa Road as specified in Alternate Bid Schedule 3. Via Volcano is a road that is currently dedicated and accepted for public use and is maintained by Tenaja Community Services District (TCSD); however, the County and TCSD agree that Via Volcano serves as a commuter route and is better suited to be a County maintained road. A service agreement between the County of Riverside and TCSD for Via Volcano seal improvements prior to intended acceptance into the County Maintained Road System will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

An approximate 700-foot segment of Murrieta Hot Springs Road is in the City of Temecula. The City of Temecula has been invited to participate in the project and work within the City of Temecula as specified in Alternate Bid Schedule 4. If the low bid is approved and concurred to by the City of Temecula, a Reimbursement Agreement between the City of Temecula and County of Riverside will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) describes the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of existing public facilities, with negligible or no expansion of an existing facility, to be considered as a categorical exemption under CEQA. This project qualifies under this exemption since it is a repair and maintenance activity taking place on existing County roads.

The slurry seal treatment will extend the life of suitable roads and reduce the need for resurfacing, which is ten times more costly. These improvements will also improve public safety.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$3,090,875, and construction is expected to start in Summer 2017. The slurry seal contract will be funded with Measure A/Western, City of Temecula, and Tenaja Community Service District funds.



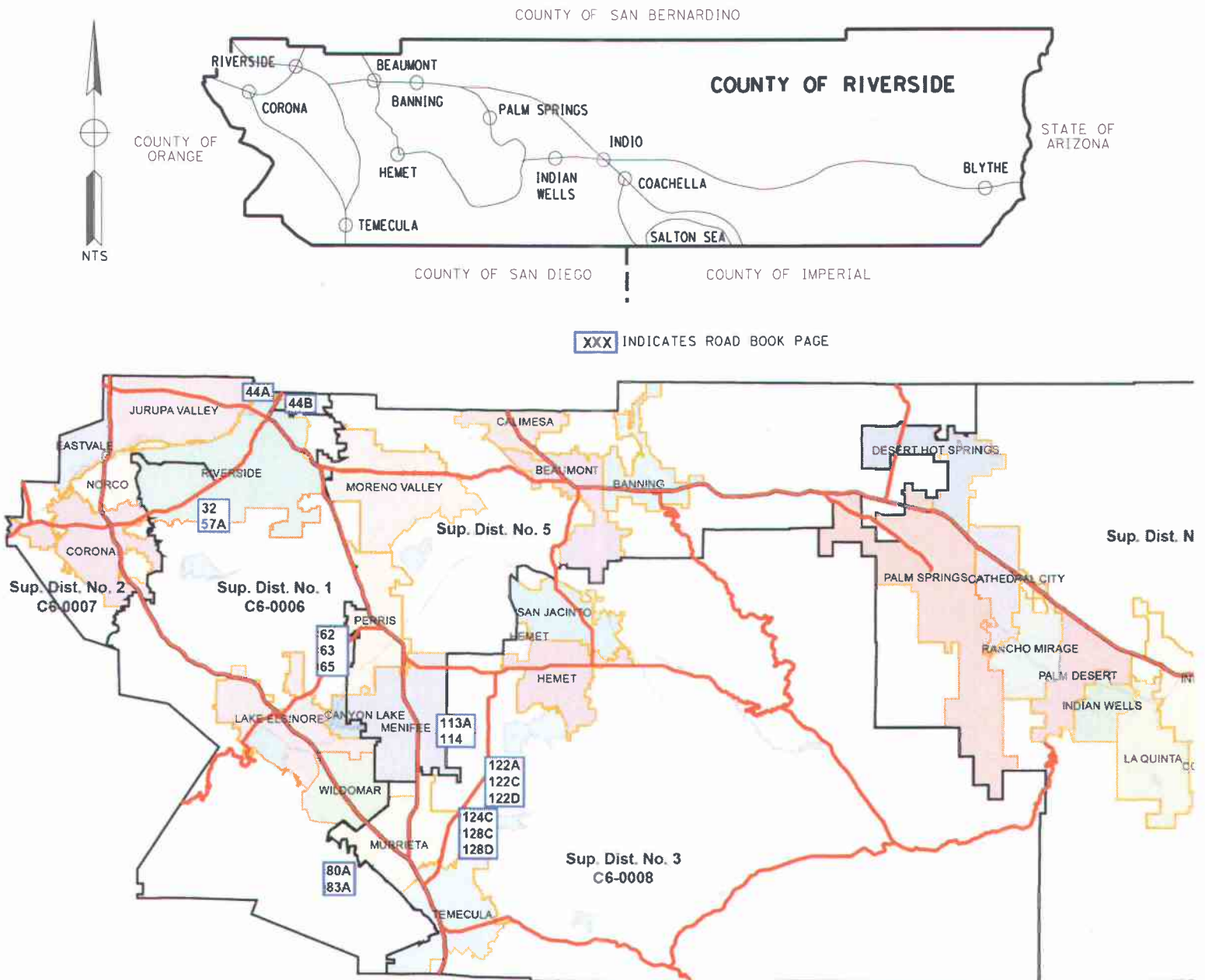

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: Districts 1, 2 & 3

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (COUNTY) proposes to provide slurry seal and chip seal treatments to existing pavement surfaces on various roads located in Districts 1, 2 and 3 of Riverside County. The work also involves replacing non-compliant curb ramps, removing and replacing thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings/paint traffic stripes, as well as, other work that may be required. Because all improvements will be conducted within the County's right-of-way, the project will not involve the acquisition of additional right-of-way.

Slurry seal treatments consist of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small crushed rock), water, and other additives applied over the existing asphalt pavement surface. The treatments are implemented as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the current pavement and postpone the requirement for more costly pavement rehabilitation. Slurry seal treatments: 1) seal cracks, 2) restore lost pavement surface flexibility, 3) renew black pavement surface color, and 4) preserve the underlying pavement structure.

The Chip seal treatment adds a layer of "chips" or small crushed rock, over the slurry seal, which is used as a "wearing course" in areas of higher vehicle traffic. The Rubberized Chip seal treatment is the same as the Chip seal treatment; however, the chips are preheated and pre-coated with asphalt emulsion, and a sand flush coat is placed over the rubberized chips. Furthermore, crumb rubber, generated from processed scrap tires, which serves as a "modifier" will be added to the asphalt emulsion. In addition, crumb rubber is added, which gives the asphalt emulsion greater viscosity and improves pavement performance/properties, resulting in resistance to reflective cracking, resistance to rutting, and the longevity of the pavement life.

Furthermore, the project will involve the use of micro-surfacing. Micro-surfacing is similar to slurry seal because it consists of the application of a mixture of water, asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small crushed rock), and chemical additives to an existing asphalt concrete pavement surface. Micro-surfacing also contains chemical additives which allow the material mixture to cure without relying on the sun or heat for evaporation.

See the attached Slurry Seal Project maps which identify the roads proposed for improvement. And see the Slurry Seal Treatment Index (p. 2) which lists the roads within each County Supervisorial District.

All roads are located within the Western Riverside County MSHCP. Many roads are located outside MSHCP Criteria Cells or Public/Quasi Public Lands. In this case, Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP has been interpreted,¹ such that, necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety improvements, along existing roadways, outside Criteria Cells or Public/Quasi Public Lands are considered Covered Activities and are exempt from MSHCP survey and mitigation requirement. However, MSHCP Appendix C Best Management Practices (BMPs) will apply.

For the slurry seal improvements within Public/Quasi Public Lands and/or Criteria Cells, Sections 7.2.1 and 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP state that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are permitted and are considered Covered Activities, subject to MSCHP Appendix C BMPs.

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposal qualifies for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines. The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

**California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities –
There will be negligible or no expansion of existing use because the slurry seal activities will take place within the existing right-of-way. Existing streets are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c).**

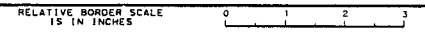
