



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. San Jacinto Chamber of Commerce (\$3,000.00) - \$1,000 of the funds will support the San Jacinto State of the City event and \$2,000 will be used for Candy Corner, a safe alternative to trick-or-treating for San Jacinto Valley's children.
2. Hemet Library Foundation (\$2,500.00) - the funding will support Adult Literacy Services, which provides educational opportunities to the functionally illiterate, as well as the Reading Program, which improves the education and enhances the lives of up to 800 children.
3. Idyllwild Arts Foundation (\$2,500.00) - the funding will support the general operations of Idyllwild Arts Foundation Jazz in the Pines 2017, an enriching weekend of jazz performances.
4. Operation Silver Star (\$1,000.00) - the funding will support the Veterans Support and Outreach Program, which offers emergency financial, logistic, and material assistance to wounded and returning combat veterans and their families.
