RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Find that the Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) (existing facilities) and Section 15301 (f) (addition of safety devices); and
- 2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Gilman Springs Road and State Highway 79 (SH-79) Northbound Ramps in the Gilman Hot Springs area; and
- 3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 16, 2017 at which time bids will be opened; and
- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the installation of a traffic signal, lighting and intersection improvements at the intersection of Gilman Springs Road and State Highway 79 (SH-79) Northbound ramps. At this intersection, Gilman Spring Road is a two lane highway that travels in the east-west direction with two 12-feet wide through lanes and a 12-feet wide left-turn pocket for the northbound on-ramp.

Construction includes installing a new traffic signal and lighting, new handicap ramps, curb and gutter and other incidental work, including new signs and markings, and pavement slurry seal along Gilman Springs Road between the Southbound exit and Northbound entrance ramps.

The signalization of the entrance and exit ramps of SH-79 is being done in partnership with Caltrans. On May 2017, the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) began construction of the traffic signal improvements at the intersection of the Gilman Springs Road and SH-79 Southbound Ramp. The Caltrans project includes roadway widening along Gilman Springs Road to accommodate two-through lanes of traffic between the ramps intersections. This Caltrans project is estimated to be completed in September 2017.

This Project will allow for the construction of the traffic signal at the Northbound entrance ramp to SH-79. The traffic signal will be within the Caltrans right-of-way and all future maintenance of the traffic signal will be the responsibility of Caltrans

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The Gilman Springs Road and SH-79 Northbound Ramp Traffic Signal and Lighting Project is a minor alteration of an existing facility. No right-of-way will be required as part of the project. The project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301(c) and 15301 (f), which describes the minor alteration of existing public facilities and addition of safety protection devices. The project will occur on an existing

roadway and will not expand the use beyond its existing use and the project will improve safety in the existing intersection through the installation of a traffic signal and lighting; consequently, the project qualifies as an exemption under Section 15301(c) and 15301 (f) of CEQA.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$378,450. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2017/2018 and will be funded with West County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities. All future operation and maintenance of the traffic signal will be the responsibility of Caltrans.

There are no General Funds used in this project.



NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

PROJECT TITLE: Gilman Springs Road and State Highway 79 Northbound On/Off Ramps Traffic Signal and Lighting Project

PROJECT LOCATION: San Jacinto area of unincorporated Riverside County

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: District 5

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department is proposing traffic and lighting improvements at the intersection of State Highway 79 (SH-79) northbound On/Off ramps and Gilman Springs Road. Improvements will occur 300 feet (ft) north, 800 ft south, 450 ft west, and 900 ft east of the intersection of SH-79 northbound on/off and Gilman Springs Road.

Gilman Springs Road is currently a two lane highway that travels in the east-west directions with two (2) 12 foot wide through lanes, 8 foot paved shoulder, 12 foot painted median, and 12 foot left-turn pocket for the northbound on ramp. SH-79 northbound On/Off ramps each have two (2) 12 foot lanes and 8 foot paved shoulder exiting and entering SH-79.

The project includes installing a new traffic signal and lighting, handicap ramps, curb and gutter, and other incidental work including but not limited to new signs and marking. The traffic signal installation will assign vehicle right of way to improve intersection safety for roadway users.

The proposed project will be constructed within the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) right of way and the County will coordinate with Caltrans for an encroachment permit prior to construction. The area in the immediate vicinity is undeveloped and there is no proposed vegetation removal.

Reason Why Project is Exempt

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposal qualifies for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. The proposed project occurs on an existing roadway and is not capacity enhancing therefore this project does not expand the existing use of the roadway. The project is consistent with Categorical Exemption 15301 (c) which exempts existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities.

Furthermore, the project will improve safety in the existing intersection through the installation of a traffic signal that will assign vehicle right of way and will illuminate the area with lighting improvements. The project is also consistent with Categorical Exemption 15301 (f) which exempts the addition of safety or health protection devices for use during construction of or in conjunction with existing structures, facilities, or mechanical equipment, or topographical features.
