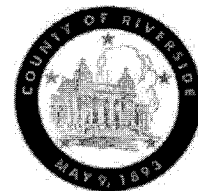

TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT: Approval of the Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise for Bid for the Grapefruit Boulevard/ State Route 111 and 4th Street Pedestrian and Roadway Improvement project, and 4th Street Sidewalk Crossing Union Pacific Railroad Tracks project in the Community of Mecca, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Exempt. 4th District (Clerk to Advertise); [\$1,725,000 total]; Federal Funds 88%, Local Funds 12%.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the 4th Street Sidewalk Crossing Union Pacific Railroad Tracks project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Grapefruit Boulevard/ State Route 111 and 4th Street Pedestrian and Roadway Improvement project, and 4th Street Sidewalk Crossing Union Pacific Railroad Tracks project in the Community of Mecca; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 23, 2017 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Two Transportation Improvement Projects have been combined to bid as one project to reduce overhead costs and receive more favorable unit costs associated with larger quantities of work.

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Grapefruit Boulevard/ State Route 111 (SR-111) and 4th Street Pedestrian and Roadway Improvement project; and the 4th Street Sidewalk Crossing Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Tracks project, both in the Community of Mecca in the east Coachella Valley area of Riverside County.

Grapefruit Boulevard/ SR-111 and 4th Street Pedestrian and Roadway Improvement Project

In 2013, the State of California established the Active Transportation Program (ATP), which consolidated existing federal and state transportation programs into a single program to fund projects that promote active modes of transportation, such as walking and biking, as alternatives to driving. The goals of the program include enhancing public health, increasing mobility for non-motorized users, increasing public safety, reducing greenhouse gas effects, and providing improvements to disadvantaged communities.

In 2014, the County of Riverside (County) Transportation Department (Transportation Department) submitted an ATP program application for the design and construction of an improved pedestrian route between St. Anthony's mobile home park and downtown Mecca for residents to access the schools, bus stops, markets, medical clinic, library, post office, and Boys & Girls Club. The estimated 500 residents at St. Anthony's mobile home park, along with other residents in the area, will benefit from this connection.

The scope of work includes widening the existing asphalt concrete paved shoulder along the west side of SR-111 and Grapefruit Boulevard to provide an eight-foot striped buffer and five-foot paved walkway from St. Anthony's Mobile Home Park, located a half-mile south of 66th Avenue, to the intersection of Grapefruit Boulevard and 4th Street. (Note: SR-111 changes name to Grapefruit Boulevard north of 66th Avenue.) From the intersection of Grapefruit Boulevard and 4th Street, to the Union Pacific Railroad tracks, a concrete sidewalk will be constructed along the north side of the road. The project will include the addition of curb ramps and replacement of traffic signal poles at the intersection of

Grapefruit Boulevard and 4th Street, and will include widening the box culvert bridge on 4th Street to accommodate truck turning movements. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the pedestrian improvements will be accessible to persons with disabilities. This project will be constructed primarily with Federal ATP funds.

4th Street Sidewalk Crossing UPRR Tracks Project

This project, in coordination with the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR), is a continuation of sidewalk improvements along the north side of 4th street over the railroad tracks to connect with the existing sidewalk at the roundabout intersection of 4th Street and Hammond Road. This completes the sidewalk connectivity for residents in and near St. Anthony Mobile Home Park to walk to downtown Mecca businesses and services. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the pedestrian improvements will be accessible to persons with disabilities. The project additionally includes the rehabilitation of existing road pavement on Grapefruit Boulevard from 66th Avenue to 0.3 mile northerly that was not part of the scope of work of the Grapefruit Boulevard/SR-111 and 4th Street ATP project. This project will be constructed utilizing local Gas Tax funds.

The County Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive bid of the sum of the Base Bid and Alternate Bid Schedules.

The California Transportation Commission (CTC) approved the allocation ATP construction funds at its May 18, 2017 meeting. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Authorization to Proceed (E-76) was received on June 28, 2017.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

On March 8, 2016, per Agenda Item 3-19, the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors found that the Grapefruit Boulevard/SR111 and 4th Street Pedestrian and Roadway Improvement project was exempt from CEQA under a Class 1 Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15301(c) of Article 19 of the State CEQA Guidelines, and directed the Clerk of the Board to file the CEQA Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting. The Notice of Exemption was posted with the Riverside County Clerk's Office on March 8, 2016, with posting terminating on April 20, 2016. In addition, pursuant to the use of federal funds, Caltrans determined on March 1, 2016 that the project was a Categorical Exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c) activity (c)(3) of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Therefore, the environmental clearance for the Grapefruit Boulevard/SR 111 and 4th Street Pedestrian and Roadway Improvement Project has been completed.

Because the 4th Street Sidewalk Crossing UPRR Tracks project consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility, and there is no expansion of an existing roadway, this Project

qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. In accordance with Section 15301 (c), Class 1 projects consist of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing public facilities, such as highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities. Furthermore, the Coachella Valley MSHCP states that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered Covered Activities. The County Transportation Department is requesting that the Board approve this environmental determination.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The project is intended to provide improvements to a disadvantaged community and to enhance public health, increase mobility for non-motorized users, increase public safety, and reduce greenhouse gas effects through active modes of transportation. The construction of an improved pedestrian route between the St. Anthony's Mobile Home Park and downtown Mecca will benefit many residents in the area who walk to downtown businesses and services, including schools, bus stops, markets, medical clinic, library, post office, and Boys & Girls Club.

The work is scheduled to begin in Fall 2017. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately five months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,725,000. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2017/2018 and will be funded with Federal - Active Transportation Plan (ATP), Gas Tax / HUTA, and Combined Improvement funds.

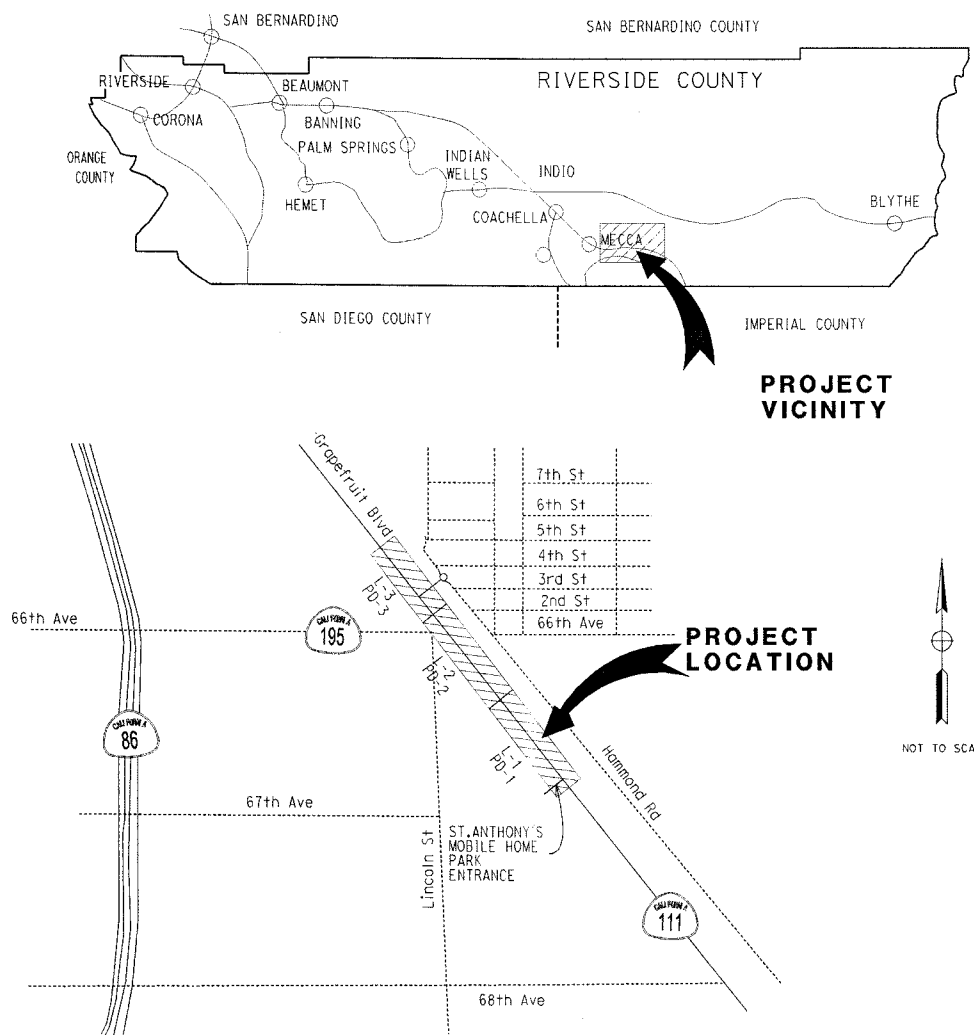

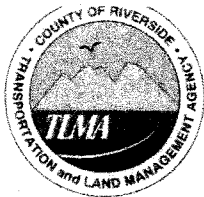

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to construct approximately 300 feet of sidewalk along the north side of 4th Street between Grapefruit Boulevard and the Hammond Road Roundabout in the community of Mecca. The construction includes concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, minor pavement, removal of guardrail, adjustment of utilities, sign installation, pavement delineation, installation of concrete track panels by Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR), and other associated work. The Project includes cooperation with the UPRR, including the acquisition of approximately 1,000 square feet of right-of-way. The purpose of the project is to provide an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible pedestrian route over the railroad tracks and to increase public safety.

The project also includes the rehabilitation of existing road pavement on Grapefruit Blvd from 66th Avenue to 0.3 mile northerly. The work will include cold milling the existing pavement and applying asphalt concrete overlay and slurry seal.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

Because the Project, as described above, consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility, and there is no expansion of an existing roadway, this Project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. Furthermore, the Coachella Valley MSHCP states that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered Covered Activities.

The Transportation Department staff conducted a review of the project and determined that the project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA

Guidelines, Article 19 commencing with Section 15300. In accordance with Section 15301 (c), Class 1 projects consist of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing public facilities, such as highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities.


