BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside has a legacy redevelopment pass-through agreement with the City of Riverside pertaining to the City's Casa Blanca redevelopment project area that stipulates revenue allocated to the County under that agreement must be deposited to a special fund dedicated to providing specifically for the operations of the Neighborhood Clinic in the City's Casa Blanca area. During process of redevelopment dissolution, a back due amount of this revenue accumulated, which has been held per the direction of clinic management. At this time, RUHS management has requested transfer of the accumulated balance to the FQHC Ambulatory Care Clinic Fund.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This revenue source is specifically dedicated to providing public health services at the County's Neighborhood Clinic to the residents in the Casa Blanca area in the City of Riverside.
